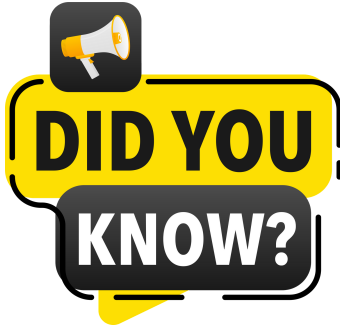

Income Eligibility in ParentVUE

Each year, parents and guardians must complete the "Alternative Form for Income-based Eligibility" during the student information update in Synergy to help Tolleson Union High School District determine program eligibility—even though all students receive free lunches.

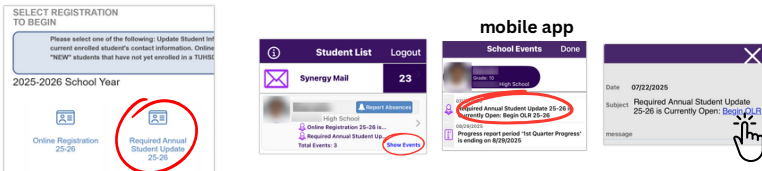


- Information provided in this form helps the district determine eligibility for **additional programs and fee waivers** based on your family's income.
- The form must be completed yearly in the "Required Annual Student Update." This must be completed before you can access other parts of ParentVUE.
- You can access the form through ParentVUE.
- If your family's income status changes during the school year, update your student's information in Synergy to ensure the school has accurate records.

What Do I Need to Do?

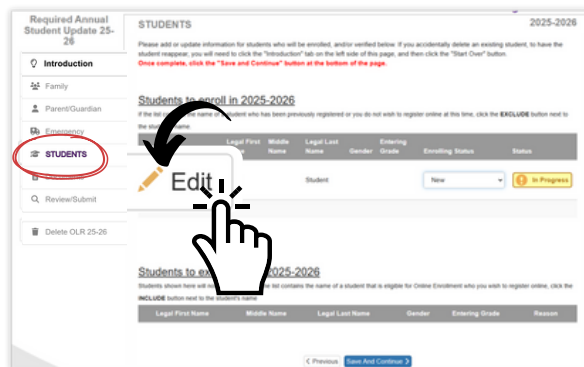


1. Log in to ParentVUE when the update period starts. You'll be guided to the update process automatically.



2. Go through the update pages until you see your student's information.

3. Click "Edit" next to your student's name and answer the required questions to get to the income eligibility form.



4. If nothing has changed, you can skip those sections.
5. Make sure you finish the form and submit your updates.

The Arizona Department of Education provides the following Fiscal Year 2025 Income Guidelines for determining income eligibility for a variety of federal fun programs. This form should be utilized as an alternative means to collect income eligibility information from the student's household and organizations should completed forms for a period of three years.

Definition of Income: all items such as wages and salaries before any deductions, and other income, such as self-employment, welfare, social security, retirement benefits, unemployment compensation, worker's compensation, aid for dependent children, alimony, child support, pensions, insurance, or annuity payments.

Exclusion: the value of meals, milk, or EBT benefits to children that NOT be considered income in the household.

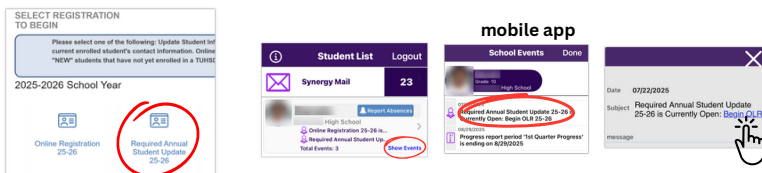

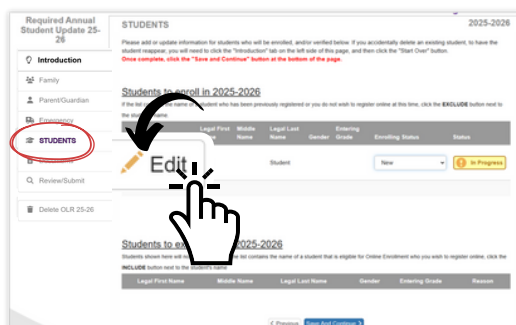
¿Qué necesito hacer?
