Dear Parents or Guardians,

Tolleson Union High School District would like to inform all stakeholders about the ACT and PreACT assessments. We are excited to announce that the district will provide funding for both the ACT and the PreACT.

The PreACT empowers all sophomores with a unique ACT test practice experience. Scores provide valuable insights into students predicted performance on the ACT and help inform important high school course decisions. PreACT reporting includes both academic and career indicators, which are designed to identify strengths and areas for improvement, providing a complete view of students' college and career readiness.

The ACT will be taken by all juniors. This assessment will serve as an excellent prep for the Spring Arizona required ACT Assessment. Additionally, the ACT is an optional assessment for seniors who have already registered to participate. The ACT is a nationally recognized and timed assessment. Students will receive a score that provides them with feedback on their core academic skills, critical thinking and problem-solving skills, behavior skills related to success in education and the workforce, and career navigation skills.

The testing date will be October 21st (PreACT/sophomores) and October 28th (ACT/juniors), 2025. These testing dates are required.

- Buses will pick up all testers taking the ACT and PreACT assessments at their regular bus stop and pick-up time.
- Students who are not testing will be given virtual assignments in advance for all their classes on the day of testing. Students who complete assignments will be counted present for a virtual learning day. The assignments must be completed and submitted on that date. Sophomores, PreACT testers will be released at 11:30 unless students are late testers. Juniors, ACT testers will be released at 12:55 unless students are late testers.
