Protect Your Personal Information When Using AI Tools

## What is PII?

- PII stands for **Personally Identifiable Information**.
- It includes any details that can be used to identify you or your family.

## Why Should You Keep PII Out of AI Tools?

- AI tools are powerful, but they are not private.
- Once you enter personal information, it may be stored, shared, or used in ways you can't control.
- To stay safe, never type PII into AI websites, apps, or chatbots.

## Examples of PII You Should NEVER Share:

### About You or Your Family

- Full name (first and last)
- Home address
- Phone number
- Email address
- Birthdate
- Social Security Number (SSN)
- Student ID number
- Parent or guardian names

### About Your School Life

- School name and location
- Class schedule
- Teacher names
- Bus route or pickup/drop-off info

### Financial or Login Info

- Credit card or bank info
- Username or password
- Login info for school accounts (like email, Canvas, etc.)

### Health or Safety Info

- Medical conditions
- Medications
- Counseling or therapy details



Think before you type—AI doesn't forget what you tell it. Once it's in AI, it's out of your hands. Keep your info safe.
