The MYP curriculum includes eight subject groups:

- Language Acquisition
- Individuals and Societies
- Sciences
- Mathematics
- Arts
- Physical and Health Education
- Design

Students explore these subjects through conceptual understanding, developing skills they'll use throughout their lives.

What Makes MYP Different?

Students engage in interdisciplinary learning that mirrors how we solve problems in the real world. Rather than memorizing facts, MYP students develop Approaches to Learning skills: communication, social, self-management, research, and thinking skills that transfer to any challenge they face.

The Personal Project: Your Showcase

In grade 10, every MYP student completes a
Personal Project — a self-directed exploration
of a topic they're passionate about. Students
identify a goal, plan their approach, create a
product or outcome, and reflect on their
learning. It's an opportunity to demonstrate
creativity, take action, and develop project
management skills.
