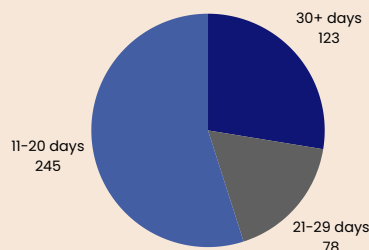
Westview High School's Beyond the Bell program proudly wrapped up its second year in 2025, marking a year of remarkable growth in student, staff, and family participation. Over 30 dedicated staff members supported our after-school and summer programs, 50 families joined our Family Engagement events, and a record 805 students participated in activities throughout the year.

This year, we expanded our offerings to provide something for every interest. Students explored fitness through HIIT classes and co-ed Volleyball, developed creativity in Art Guild and Knight Thyme Cooks, strengthened academic skills in Book Club, Level Up: AP Prep, and Westview Review: Crush the ACT, and discovered new passions in Dungeons & Dragons, Rocket People STEM projects, and Knights Insight Therapy Lab.

It was an outstanding year for Beyond the Bell, and we look forward to continuing to inspire, engage, and support our students as the program continues to grow!

STUDENT ATTENDANCE

We had 805 students attend 1 or more days of the program. Of those students, 123 attended for 30 days or more, helping us achieve our program goal.
