West Point High School Goals 25-26

Graduate all students in the 2026 Senior Class

- Increase graduation rate by 2% and/or meet 90%

Increase academic achievement of all students

- Increase Proficiency scores on ACT by 10%

- Prepare all students for college and career
- Increase success in Advanced Placement and Dual Enrollment
- 10% increase in DE Enrollment

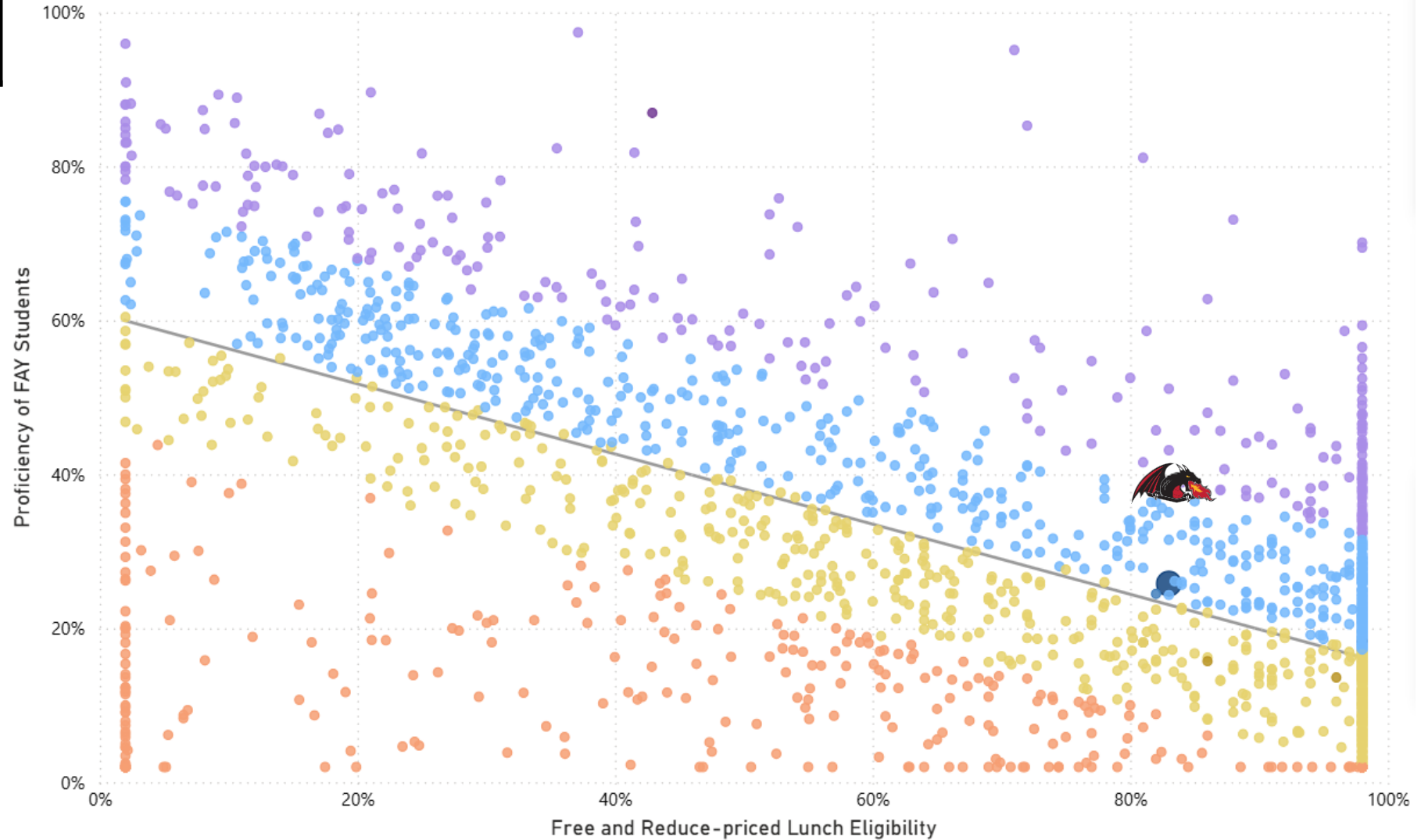

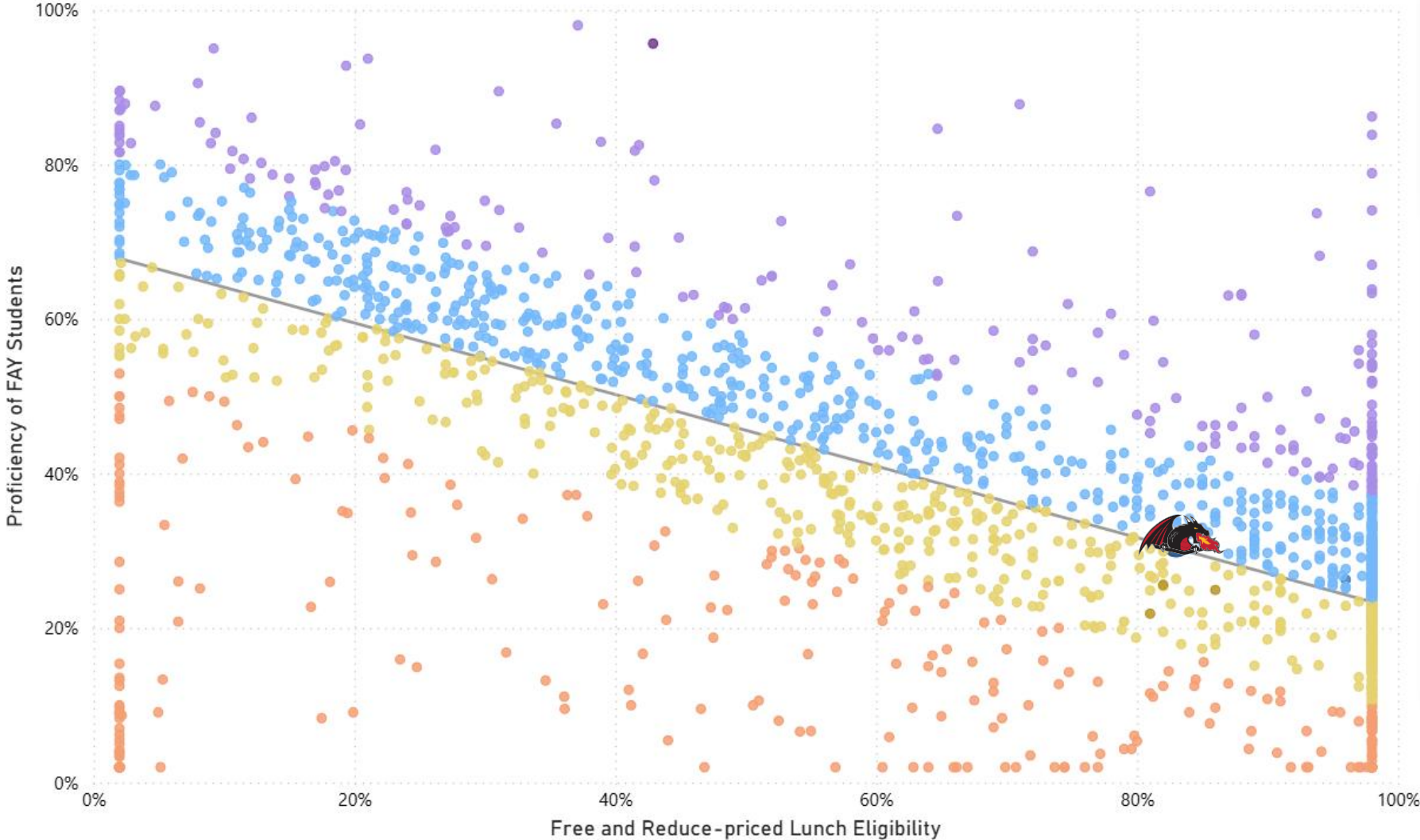

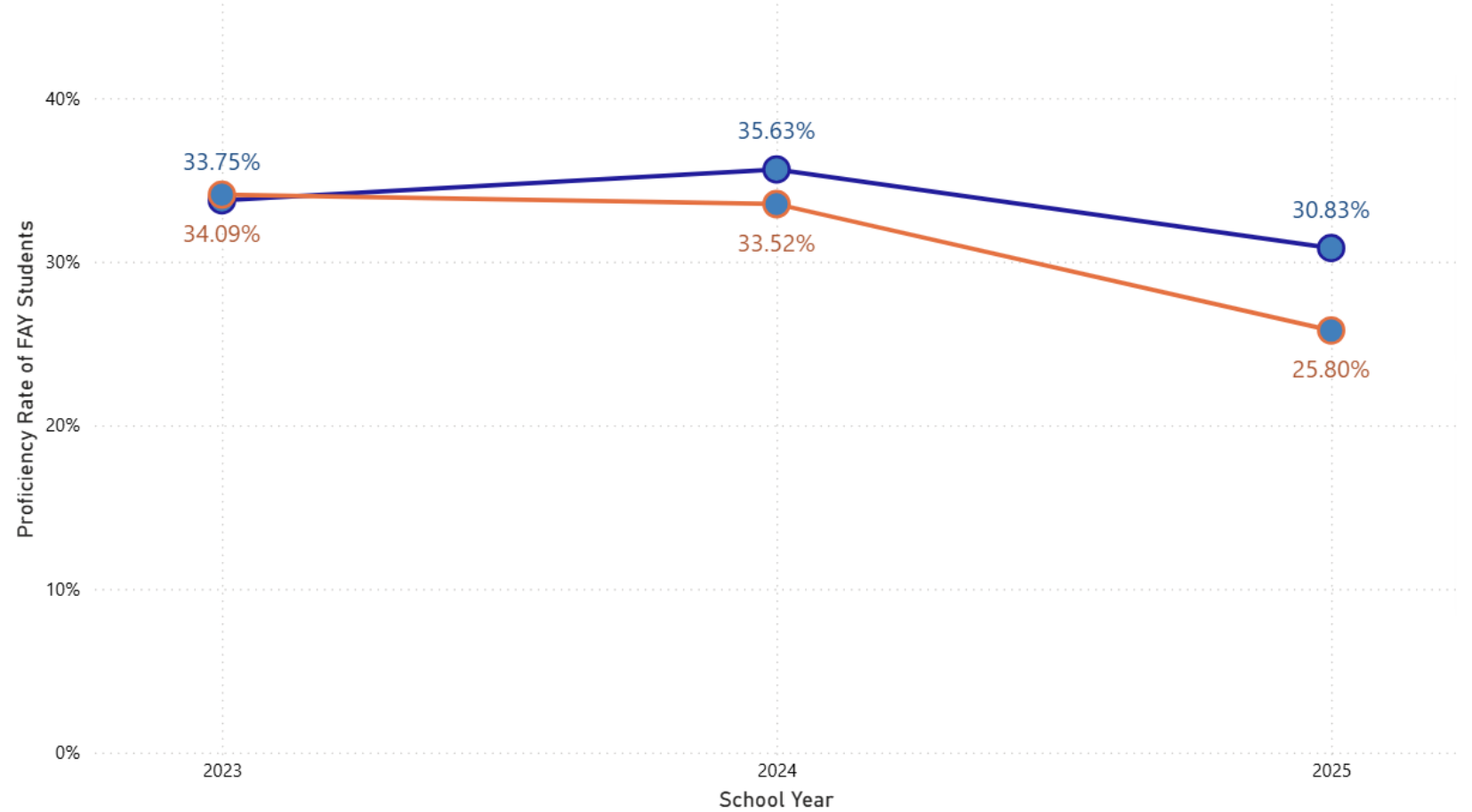


ELA & Math ACT Data Proficiency

ELA & Math Proficiency by Year

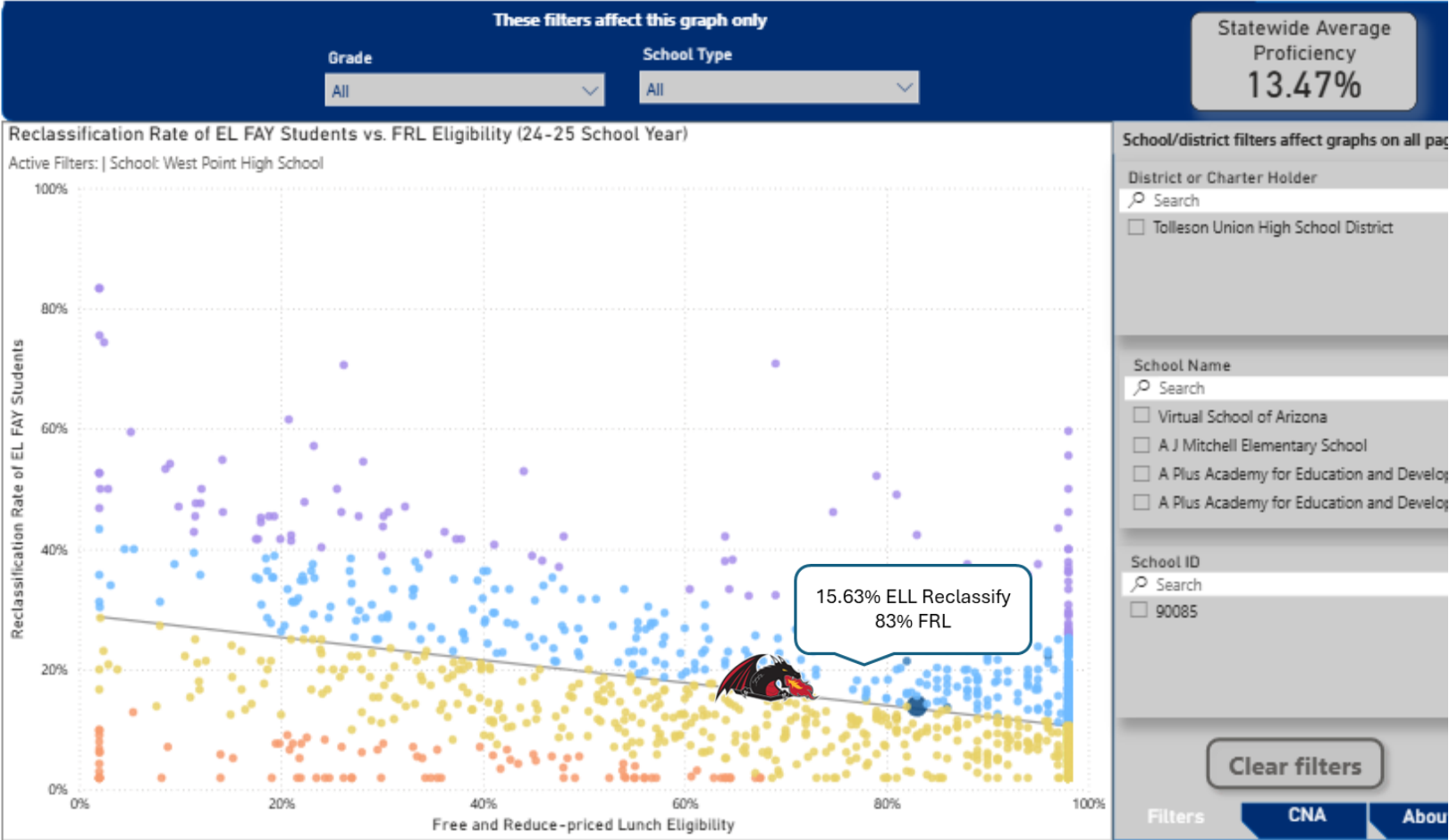

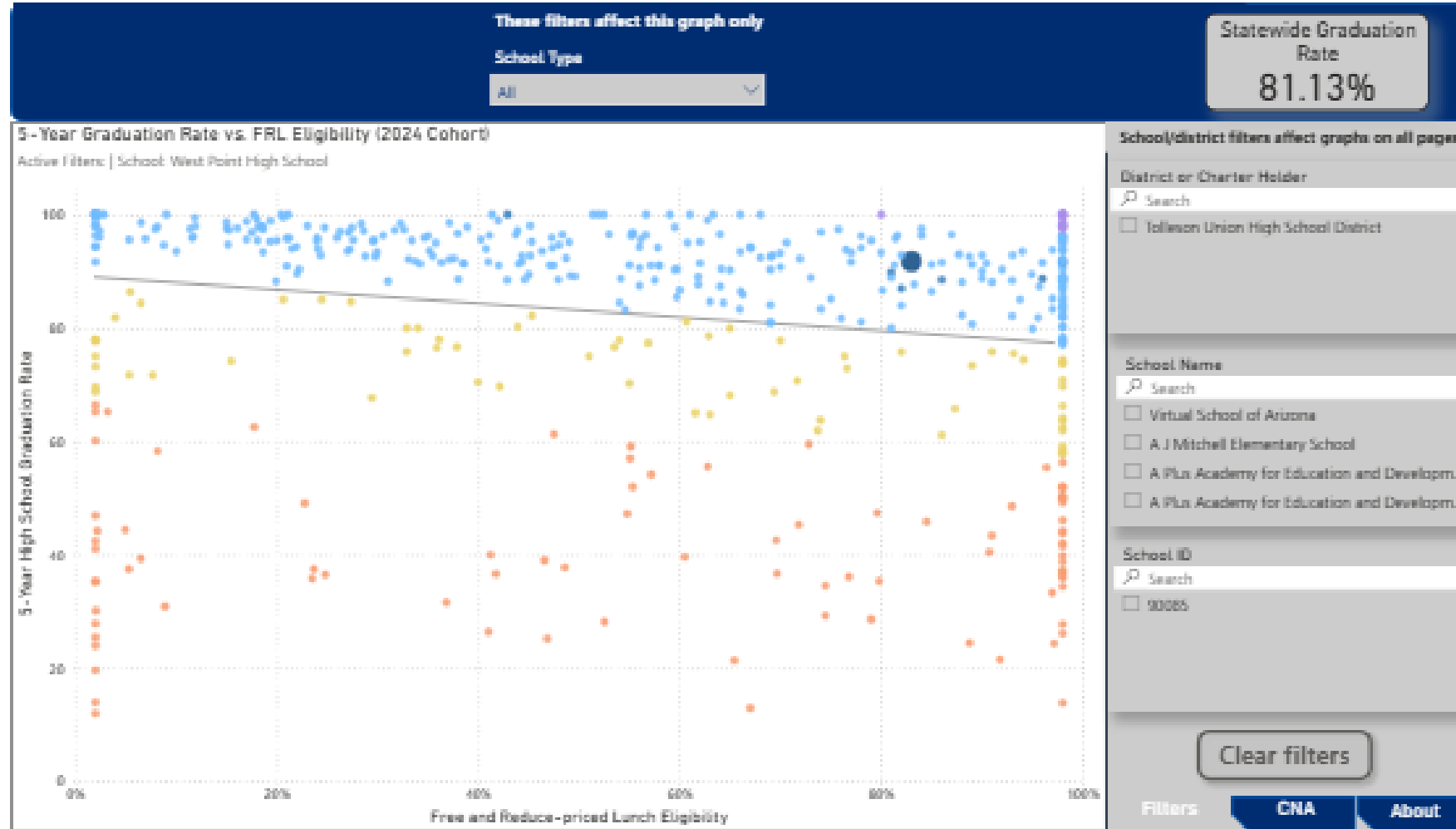

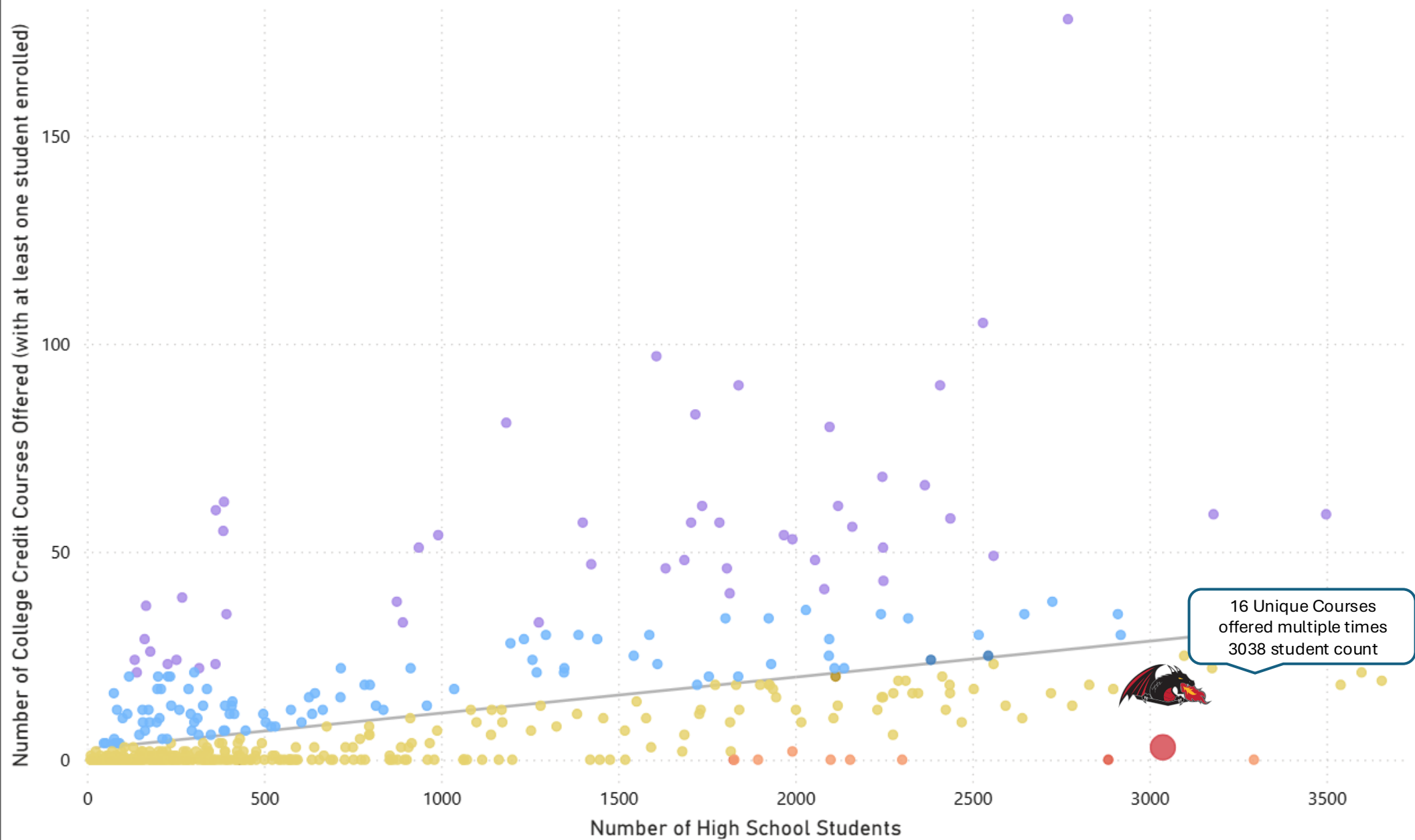

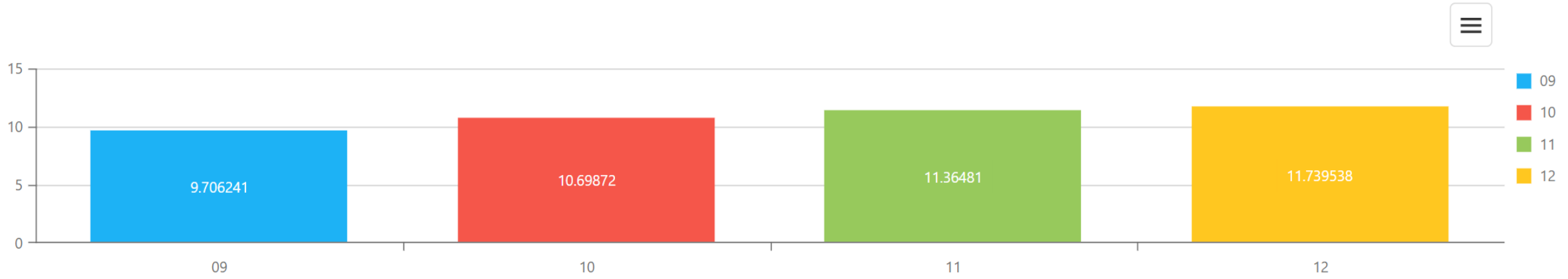
College Credit Courses Offered vs. High School Enrollment (24-25 School Year)

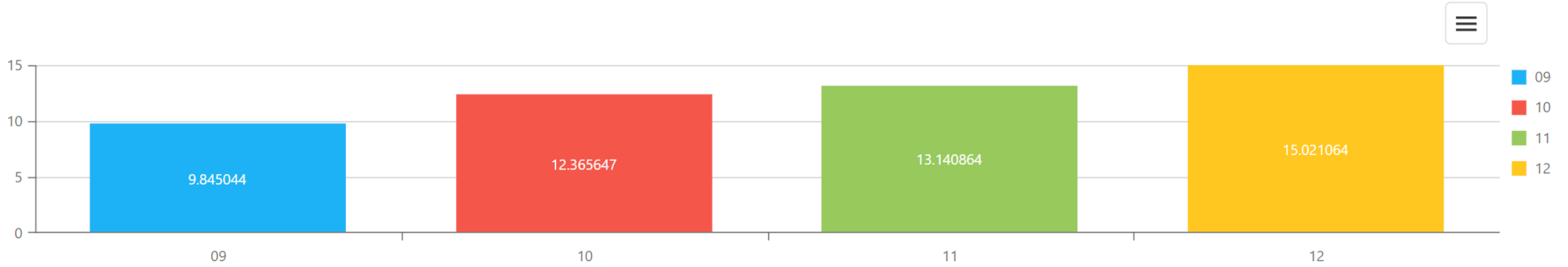
Absent Rate by Grade

New Personal Electronic Device State Law and Policy



- Students must place their personal electronic devices (phones, headphones, earbuds, etc.) in their backpack or personal bag, or in the classroom lockbox. Devices may not be kept on their person during class.

DEN – Dragons Engage Now

Happens most Tuesday and Thursdays using the Advisory/DEN bell schedule which allows for a 25-minute period after 3rd hour.
