

**Founded in 2019**

West Point High School is part of the Tolleson Union High School District and is located in Avondale. West Point is the only comprehensive high school in the district to receive an A rating. This achievement highlights the school's dedication to academic excellence and student success. With a strong focus on challenging coursework and hands-on learning, West Point provides a supportive environment where students can thrive.

Our teachers and staff are committed to preparing students for success in careers, military pursuits or post-secondary education. The school has a STEAM (science, technology, engineering, arts and mathematics) focus as well as a Leadership Academy program.

West Point has academic and personal supports available through our Guidance Counselors, Social Workers, Intervention/Prevention Specialists, Exceptional Student Services, the School Psychologist, 504 plans, and ELD programs.

## Leadership Academy

The West Point Leadership Academy is a four-year program that is dedicated to developing students' academic and leadership skills. Our school-within-a-school model is focused on every student earning admission to a university with the skills necessary to succeed. Academy students develop the academic strength and leadership skills necessary to compete globally. The program is open to any student wanting to enroll.
