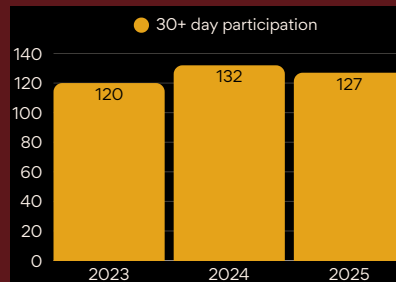

Program Recap

In its third year, Tolleson High School's Winner's Circle program continued to excel, meeting and exceeding program goals. Nearly all participating students—96%—reported building positive connections with peers and staff, and 92% shared that the program fostered a stronger sense of belonging and positive feelings toward school. Our Family Engagement events reached 145 families, and 38 dedicated staff members contributed to after-school and summer programming.

This year brought exciting growth in program offerings. WolverEats expanded culinary opportunities for students, while Literacy Legends! helped freshmen improve their Lexile levels and reading comprehension. Infinite Fantasy, our Wolverine book club, sparked imagination and a love of reading, and Speed & Agility Builders supported year-round athletic conditioning. We also introduced Dungeons & Dragons, creating new connections one campaign at a time, and gave students creative outlets through Passion for Fashion and Crochet Club, where they produced unique, wearable art.

Winner's Circle continues to inspire, connect, and empower students, and we look forward to another year of growth and success.
