

TUHS MCJROTC UNIFORM ISSUANCE AGREEMENT

I agree to receive issued MCJROTC uniforms and understand the following conditions:

1. I will be responsible for the uniform items until I turn them in when directed by the Marine Instructors.
2. I will only initial for items that I have actually received and upon turning in items will ensure they are properly marked off my uniform issue sheet.
3. I am aware that I must turn in the uniforms personally and that they will not be accepted through a third party without prior approval from the Marine Instructors
4. I am aware that the current government prices are printed by each uniform item and that these prices may increase during the course of the school year.
5. I am aware that I am required to replace, at my own expense, any and all uniform items that I lose or damage irresponsibly and that replacement will be the cash value of the uniforms at the time of turn in.
6. I am aware that there is no charge for normal wear and tear of the uniform.
7. I agree to wear the uniform on designated uniform days during the school year for the entire school day in accordance with uniform regulations and will maintain an appropriate personal appearance while wearing the MCJROTC uniform and maintain my uniform in a clean and orderly condition at all times (laundering in accordance with tags and on a regular basis).
8. I will not lend part or all of my uniform to other cadets or non-cadets for any reason.
9. I understand I cannot wear my camouflage utility uniform to a restaurant or other place of business without specific authorization from the Senior Marine Instructor.
10. I agree that prior to turn in I will have all camouflage utility uniform pieces and physical training (PT) uniforms **LAUNDERED**, and have all Service uniform pieces **PROFESSIONALLY DRYCLEANED**. Sweats will be home laundered prior to turn in. Failure to launder or professionally dry clean any uniform items can result in termination from the MCJROTC program, including but not limited to the following school year.
11. I am aware that it is an honor to wear the Marine Corps uniform that has been worn with pride by Marines since their founding on 10 November 1775 and will not do anything to embarrass that tradition.
