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### First Day of School and Meals

On the first day of school, parents will say goodbye at the entrance. Walking students to classrooms will not be allowed. We understand that, especially for our Kindergarten families, this is a special milestone. To help your child build independence and adjust smoothly, Kinder students will also enter on their own and be guided by staff to their classroom. Please start having these conversations with your child now and use Meet the Teacher Night to practice how this will work.

- Student drop-off begins at 7:15 a.m. Please do not drop off students before 7:15 a.m.
- All students will gather in the cafeteria when they arrive, sit in their homeroom section, and follow our 4Bs while waiting for their homeroom teacher.
- We will have a welcome assembly before they proceed to their homeroom.
- Breakfast and lunch will continue to be provided free for all students every day.
- Students will begin walking to class at 7:45 a.m.
- Students arriving after 8:00 a.m. are considered late and must get a pass from the front office.
- The first day of school is Monday, July 28.

### **How We Communicate with Families**

Strong communication is key to student success. RTS will keep you informed through:

- ClassDojo: Teachers will share a new ClassDojo code for their homeroom during Meet the Teacher Night so you can connect right away. Please join to stay updated on class news and reminders.
- Phone Calls & Emails: For important updates and concerns.
- Monthly Newsletters: With school-wide news, dates, and celebrations.
- School Website & Flyers: For announcements and upcoming events.

Please make sure your phone and email are current and reach out to the front office if you need help connecting to ClassDojo.





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## Transportation & Parent/Student Pick-Up Cards

During Meet the Teacher Night, you will receive two student cards with your child's name, grade, and homeroom teacher. These cards are required for daily pick-up and bus dismissal for safety:

- Parent Pick-Up: Display the card on your dashboard at pick-up so staff can call your child by radio. If you do not have your card, you must pick up your child at the front office or pick up the student card at the front office before getting in the pick-up line at the front of the cafeteria. Please make sure you have your student card with you every day to help make pick-up smooth and fast for everyone.
- Bus Riders:
  - o 1st-4th grade students may get off the bus and walk home or to your car.
  - o Kindergarten students must be released to an adult with the student card. You must show the card to the bus driver if you do not have it, your child will be returned to the school and must be picked up at the front office. If you wait in your car, please get out and walk to the bus door.
    - If a family member is picking up your child, they must have the student card with them. If no card is shown, your child will not be released from the bus and will be returned to the school office for safety.

If you are not able to attend Meet the Teacher Night, you may pick up your student cards at the front office on Friday, July 25 from 9:30 a.m.–3:30 p.m. or on the first day of school, Monday, July 28, starting at 7:00 a.m., or before dismissal time.

Important: If you do not have your student/parent card, your Kindergarten student will not be released at the bus stop they will be brought back to the school office for you to pick up in person. For car pick-up, students will not be released from the pick-up line if you do not have your card. You must go to the office first to pick it up before getting in line at the front of the cafeteria.

Thank you for helping us follow these procedures to ensure that all students arrive home safely every day and make dismissal smooth for all Riverside Traditional School families.





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### Parent Pick-Up Procedures & Traffic Reminders

To keep dismissal smooth and safe for everyone:

- All parents using the drive-through pick-up must display their student pick-up card clearly on the dashboard.
- A staff member will call for your child and signal you when your child is walking to your car.
- Students will enter vehicles from the passenger side (right side) only.
- If you prefer, you may park and walk your child to or from the pedestrian crossing area near the office.
- Parents must remain in their vehicle when using the drive-through lane please do not park or leave vehicles unattended in the pick-up line.

### Pick-Up Times:

- Pre-School AM Session: 11:00 a.m.
- Pre-School PM Session, Kindergarten—2nd Grade, Self-Contained: 2:50 p.m.
- 3rd–4th Grades: 2:50 p.m.

#### Traffic Flow:

- Enter campus through the main entrance and turn right.
- Drive up to the far end of the cafeteria pick-up zone.
- If the car in front of you is still waiting, you may use the left lane to exit once your child is safely in the car.
- For everyone's safety, no left turns when exiting the campus during 7:00–8:00 a.m. and 1:30–3:30 p.m.
- After pick-up, please pull forward immediately to keep the line moving smoothly.

If you do not have your student card at pick-up, you must park and go to the front office to get a temporary pass before returning to the line. Please help us avoid delays by having your card ready every day.







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### **Student ID Safety**

All RTS students will receive their official student ID on our first picture day, scheduled for August 8, 2025 during school hours.

Each student will also be given a colored lanyard one that matches their bus assignment (if they ride the bus) or one for parent pick-up and drop-off.

Student IDs are part of our school dress code and must be with students at all times. Students may keep their ID tied securely to their backpack if they prefer, but IDs must be brought to school every day.

Thank you for helping us keep students safe and make daily dismissal smooth and efficient.

#### Our 4Bs & Pride Ticket Rewards

At RTS, we teach and reinforce our four core behaviors every day:

- Be Respectful
- Be Responsible
- Be Safe
- Be Kind

To encourage and reward positive behavior, students can earn RTS Pride Tickets for following the 4Bs. Pride Tickets can be exchanged for fun rewards throughout the year.

### **Student Recognition Assemblies & Awards**

Riverside Traditional School prides itself on recognizing our students for both academic achievements and character as proud RTS Pride members. This year, we will continue to celebrate our students through school-wide assemblies and special awards ceremonies at the end of each trimester.

Some of the awards your child may earn include:

- SUPERINTENDENT'S LIST For students selected by teachers who exceed expectations in academics, behavior, attitude, and character. These students are recognized at an RESD Governing Board meeting.
- PRINCIPAL'S LIST For students who earn all A's on their end-of-trimester report card.
- HONOR ROLL For students who earn all A's and B's on their end-of-trimester report card.





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- THE 4Bs STUDENT OF THE MONTH One student each month from each class who exemplifies being Respectful, Responsible, Safe, and Kind.
- PERFECT ATTENDANCE Monthly attendance recognition alongside Student of the Month.
- Other Possible Awards State Assessment (AASA & AZELLA), iReady Math & Reading Growth, RESD Benchmark Growth, DIBELS Growth, and other special recognitions.

We are proud to recognize our students' hard work and great choices.

### **Dress Code Highlights**

To keep students focused and safe, please remember:

- Tops: Solid red for grades 1–4, baby blue for Kindergarten. Collared, tucked in, with no logos except the school logo.
- Bottoms: Khaki pants, shorts, skirts, or jumpers. No jeans or denim.
- Sweaters/Jackets: Solid red, black, and gray colors only.
- Shoes: Closed-toe, closed-heel shoes only.
- Earrings: Girls may wear only one earring per ear, with earrings no larger or longer than the size of a quarter. No pierced jewelry may be worn by boys.
- Hair & Grooming: Hair must be a natural color only; no mohawks, designs, or unnatural colors. No writing on skin or clothing.

You will receive the Student Handbook with complete information about our dress code, infractions, and disciplinary actions. Please review the handbook carefully before signing and returning the acknowledgment form. Thank you for helping us maintain a safe, respectful learning environment for every student.
