



Approval of Minutes – November 2025 minutes – Dr. Simmons found an error in the November 2025 minutes. **Motion** Chairman Jackson asked if the board if we can move to make the corrections over the minutes, *Dr. Pipkins moved and Michael Williams seconded, unanimously approved 4-0.*

- IV. Principals Report – Principal Hewson was out due to family emergency. Ms. Hawkins read Principal Hewson report. *Mr. Williams motioned and Dr. Simmons seconded, unanimously approved the principal report. 4-0.*



- V. Superintendent Report - Superintendent Hawkins gave an update on building repairs regarding the roof leaks. Financial statements were reviewed by the board and Ms. Hawkins shared the deficient is related to outstanding grant drawdowns. Staff vacancies still exist, but GGPA has long-term substitutes. We are preparing for next school year and is reviewing staff performance. Prop 301 money was paid and due to low enrollment, all teaching staff received \$750 each and support staff received \$300 on average. GGPA website was reinstated under a new URL code since we could not retrieve the original site that someone purchased. The board oversight committee have not met yet but will do so in the next couple of months. Board member Williams agreed to chair the committee and will call the other members Dr. Harris and Dr. Pipkin. *Motion to approve the superintendent report, Dr. Pipkins moved and Michael Williams seconded, unanimously approved 5-0.*
