



TITLE IX

OVERVIEW

Title IX of the Education Amendments of 1972 prohibits discrimination based on sex in education programs or activities, which receive Federal financial assistance. Title IX states: “No person in the United States shall, on the basis of sex, be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be subjected to discrimination under any program or activity receiving Federal financial assistance.”

Region 9 Education Cooperative (REC 9) supports Title IX and values diversity. It is the policy of the Region 9 Education Cooperative Coordinating Council to provide equal opportunities without regard to race, color, national origin, ancestry, sex, religion, age, disability, serious medical condition, disability, equal compensation, genetic information, pregnancy, sexual orientation, gender identity, veteran status or spousal affiliation in its educational program and activities. This includes, but is not limited to, educational services and any aspect of employment, including hiring, firing, pay, job assignments, promotions, layoff, training, fringe benefits, and any other term or condition of employment.
