- **Open Enrollment:** Open enrollment is when an application is submitted for a student to attend our school who **does not** live within the district or school boundaries. If you have already submitted an application and have a student in grades K-3rd and you are going to be attending the elementary school next school year 2026-2027, you **do not** need to fill out another application. If your child is in 4th grade and is advancing to the Middle School or you currently have a Pre-K student advancing to Kindergarten and do not live within the district boundaries, you **need** to fill out an application. Open enrollment began November 15 and ends February 6th. If you have questions about this, please contact the Elementary School front office.

- With the weather changing we have had more students being dropped off in the morning before school. Just a few reminders to keep things moving and to ensure your students arrive at school on time. 1. There is no parking in the drop-off/loading zone. If you need to park to bring your student into the school, parking is available in the new top lot directly south of the main parking lot. 2. Plan for extra time when the weather is bad. 3. Stay in your car and have your student exit on the left side to ensure safety. 4. Watch your speed and be aware of your surroundings when entering the pick up/drop off lane and also when entering the parking lot. Additionally, we have visitor and handicap parking available in the main parking lot. As per district policy your student will be marked tardy if they arrive after the bell rings at 8:50 am. Tardies are not excused.
- The weather is getting colder and students are outside before school and during recess and lunch. Students will have outside recess unless the temperature is

below 10 degrees. Please dress your students appropriately and send coats, gloves, hats, etc. to make your student comfortable and warm during outside play. It may also be a good idea to send an extra pair of clothes for your student to keep in their locker in case they get wet during recess.
