



South Summit School District provides a Preschool/Pre-K program promoting a child's cognitive, communication, social emotional, adaptive and motor development. This program is for three and four year old children who are developmentally age appropriate children and for those who qualify for an Individualized Education Plan (IEP) from the community. Please read the following to be well informed about our Preschool/Pre-K programs.

### What does the program look like? What are the benefits for your child?

- Classes are taught by certified and experienced teachers and staff
- The program focuses on academics and school readiness skills
- Teachers and staff strive to meet the needs of each child
- Curriculum is based on Utah State Standards
- The preschool is a clean, organized and structured environment with loving and caring teachers
- Children learn new skills, meet new friends, and have fun
- Children learn how to work and act in a school setting

### Guidelines and Information

- Children must be 3 or 4 and potty trained by September 1, 2025 (House Bill 331)
- All PreK registration begins on Thursday, February 12, 2026

#### 3 Year Old Pre-K Program

- Students will attend two days a week:
  - Mon/Wed class 9 AM - 11:00 AM**OR**
  - Tues/Thurs 9 AM - 11:00 AM
- Tuition cost: \$85 per month (Sept. - May)  
(Tuition is due the first of every month)
- Three year old classes participate in spring parent/teacher conference (TBA)
- Level Assessment (TBA)

#### 4 Year Old Pre-K Program

- Students will attend two days a week:
  - Mon/Wed class 11:30 - 3:00 PM**OR**
  - Tues/Thurs class 11:30 - 3:00 PM
- Tuition cost: \$148 per month (Sept. - May)  
(Tuition is due the first of every month)
- Four year olds will be tested three times during the year (TBA)
- Four year old classes participate in fall and spring parent/teacher conferences (TBA)



- 4 year old PreK students are required to take a beginning of the year assessment. This assessment will be given within two weeks prior to the first/last day of school.
- All PreK students will be given additional assessments throughout the year. These assessments are used to monitor student progress and guide instructional strategies throughout the year.
- To ensure clarity and answer parent questions about the PreK program, we will be holding a Parent ONLY Information Night before school starts. Day and time to be determined.
- Notification of class placement will be by email. **Space is limited, unfortunately, everyone will not be accepted into the program.** To ensure your child is eligible for acceptance into the program, **all registration and registration documents must be completed prior to placement.**
- Tuition payments can be made online at <https://family.titank12.com/>. Check and cash tuition payments can be placed in the tuition box mounted on the wall just as you enter inside the school foyer. PLEASE MAKE SURE your PreK payment isn't applied to the Titan lunch account, but to the PreK class.
- Students already attending the program will not need to register for the following school year, but please **send a commitment email** to the school registration office using the link below verifying your continued interest in the Pre-K program for the upcoming school year by **February 10, 2026**.

  - Proof of residency within district boundaries
  - All registration documents must be received BEFORE your child's place is secured
