- Parents can pick up a Battle of the Books form if your student is interested.


To **simplify** your Back to School Night you can do these things **before** coming

Cell Phone/Device Policy*

If there is a need to contact a parent/guardian during class time, students may use cell phones in the office with permission. If students are inappropriately using their phones/electronic devices, the following consequences are in place:

- After a phone is confiscated and turned into the office, it can
 be picked up at the end of the day or a parent can come pick it
 up as soon as they want. Following the infraction, the phone
 can either be left home for five days or turned into the office
 each morning for five consecutive days. Due process will be
 followed.
- Students using their cell phones to bully fellow students in any way or to share inappropriate material is unacceptable and will not be tolerated. See school behavior expectations for consequences.
- Cell phones are strictly prohibited in bathrooms and locker rooms. Use of cell phones in bathrooms or locker rooms will be treated as a violation of the law.
- To ensure the safety, privacy, and well-being of all students, the use of cell phones to take photos or videos of other students while on school grounds is <u>strictly prohibited</u>.

Student Dress Code*

Clothing depicting, through words or other visual symbols, criminal activity or violence (weapons or violent action) and/or disrespect toward any race, culture, religion, sexual orientation or gender, shall not be worn.

Clothing/apparel displaying obscene, sexually explicit, lewd, or vulgar messages or advertising substances a student cannot legally possess (tobacco, alcohol, illegal drugs) shall not be worn.

Clothing/apparel that exposes the buttocks, cleavage, bare midriff, or undergarments shall not be worn.

Purchasing Locks 6th, 7th, 8th Grade

If your child would like a lock for their locker you can purchase one on Backto-School night. Students may only use school purchased locks on their locker.

Locks will cost \$15 and your student will be responsible for keeping it.
Student will no longer turn it in at the end of the year, but can use it for all 3 years in the middle school. You can then donate it back to the school at the end of 8th grade if you do not want to keep it.

*5th Grade lockers have locks attached to the locker. Combos will be given by their 5th grade teacher.

Attendance

Policy

Few factors will have a greater influence on students' educational success than regular attendance and punctuality, and few will influence as much their future success in the workforce as the dependability and responsibility acquired from the habit of regular, punctual school attendance.

- Absences must be excused by parents within 2 days of absences.
- Unexcused absences will be considered a truancy
- After 5 truancies a letter and a parent meeting will be scheduled to determine how to best help the student.
- Tardies over 30 minutes will be marked as an absence in that class
- Students with 5 or more tardies will be required to do a Lunch-N-Learn for the 5th tardy and each tardy after.
