District Assessments

In January, we will be administering the Acadience Reading Assessment, which is used to assess a learner's reading level. The data obtained will help determine a child's need for instructional supports and intervention. This assessment is given in the fall, winter, and spring.

School Safety

The safety of our students and staff is a school district priority. Throughout the year, we conduct several safety drills. We conducted one lockdown drill in October and have another one scheduled tentatively for Wednesday, January 14th. Additionally, we perform monthly fire drills and a spring severe weather drill. These drills are very important as they give our learners and staff the opportunity to practice the proper procedures that need to be followed in the event of a real emergency.
