Parent/Teacher Conferences (Nov. 6th and 7th)

HEALTH ROOM HAPPENINGS

- **O THE BASICS:**
 - **SLEEP** School aged kids should get between 9-12 hours of sleep a night. Start a nightly routine to help them get to bed at a reasonable time.
 - NUTRITION Eating breakfast is linked to improved concentration and increased energy. Get your student to school early to get breakfast at school or make breakfast together at home.
- © **EXAMS**: The Department of Health requires all students in Kindergarten to have physical and dental exams. Please turn these in if you haven't already.
- © **STAY HOME IF**: Your student has a fever over 100.4 and keep them home until fever free for 24 hours without medication.
- © **CLOTHES**: <u>Please</u> keep an extra set of clothes in your student's backpack. Accidents happen a lot.
