Our first lockdown drill was held on Friday, October 24. School Resource Officer Max Fuller assisted in the drill. Facilitators discussed lockdown procedures and expectations with all classes.

Helpful Tips for Awesome Attendance

Research shows that missing 10 percent of school, or about 18 days per year, negatively affects a learner's academic performance. That's just two days a month and is known as chronic absenteeism. Learners with good attendance generally achieve higher grades and enjoy school more. Regular school attendance patterns encourage the development of other responsible patterns of behavior.

- Remind your child that school is their first and most important job! Tardies, late arrivals, and early release times matter!
- Communicate the importance of regular school attendance to your child so they are hearing the same thing we are saying at school.
- If your child has a doctor/dentist appointment, you can bring them before or after their appointment with the note from the doctor.

In accordance with attendance regulation, letters are mailed home after 10 absences. A doctor's excuse is required for all absences beyond 10 days. If a child is not in school regularly, is chronically tardy, or consistently leaves early, school officials are required to proceed with measures that discourage poor attendance.
