
COUNSELOR'S CORNER – Mrs. Nichols

The nurses are busy administering vision, hearing, and growth screenings for all of our students. This is a requirement by the Pennsylvania school code. If your student does not pass a screening, you will be notified. If you haven't already, you will be receiving a letter about your student's BMI. This is also a requirement to notify parents. If you have any questions about the screenings, please contact the nurse.

Accidents happen a lot, especially with our little ones. Please keep an extra set of clothes in your student's backpack for accidents or spills. We have a limited supply in the health office so this really helps us out.

ATTENDANCE POLICY

Please read this carefully and call if you have any questions.

A parent excuse is accepted for any day absent up to the total of ten (10). A doctor's excuse will be accepted for any absence during the year and is counted in the first ten (10) parental excuse days. Following the accumulation of ten (10) parent excuses, parents will receive a written notice/letter advising them of the accumulation of ten absences, and that the district will require a doctor's excuse for each day's absence from the time of the notice until the end of the school year. Please note: Vacation days are counted in the ten parental excuses. Finally, if the school does not receive an excuse within three days of an absence, the absence will be recorded as an unlawful. Parents are allowed up to three (3) unlawful absences. Letters will be sent to keep you posted of any unlawful days.



SCHOOL HOURS

The building opens for students at 7:30 a.m. To be to school on time, students should be in their classrooms by 8:15 a.m. or 12:15 p.m. for PM Prekindergarten students. Students are dismissed at 2:50 p.m. for walkers/parent pick-up for Kindergarten and 2:45 pm for PM Prekindergarten.
