Changes to Routine

Changes to a Student's Daily Routine

The following procedures have been put into place for your child's safety and security.

Late Arrivals/Early Dismissal:

- Anytime a child arrives late or leaves early, the parent or the parent's designee must accompany the child into the school to sign the child in or out.
- If an adult other than a parent is picking up a child, they must be listed as an emergency contact, and the parent must send a note with the child in the morning. The note must include the reason for the change, the time the child is to be excused, the name of the person picking the child up, and any other necessary details. Photo ID may be required when someone other than the parent is picking up a student from school.

Child Going Home with Another Student:

- If your child is planning on going home with another student, two notes are required. Both you and the other child's parent must send a note to the office in the morning that describes the arrangement.
- Titusville Area School District bus transportation cannot be used for these individual arrangements. You will need to make your own transportation arrangements for your child to go home with another student's family.

Change of Transportation Arrangements:

- If your child is not riding home on their regularly scheduled bus, a note requesting the change needs to be presented at the office in the morning. End of the day phone calls are discouraged, however, your child must be picked up by 3:00. Phone calls will only be accepted until 2:15 PM.
