- © Place Value (100s, 10s, 1s)
- Decomposing numbers (breaking apart)
- © Greater than, less than, equal (<, >, =)



- We took our Acadience tests last week. We will be sending home those scores this week and let you know if your child will be working in a small intervention group
- . Make sure your child is reading at least 20 minutes every night!
