TMS Academic Support

Rocket Block

Rocket Block is an academic support period designed to provide students with opportunities for both targeted intervention and academic enrichment. Although students are initially scheduled with a specific teacher during this time, the groups remain flexible. Grade-level teaching teams meet regularly to assess individual student progress and needs, allowing them to adjust group placements and provide more responsive, differentiated support.

Catalyst

All Catalyst teachers meet individually with their students to provide academic coaching and guidance. During these meetings, they review grades, address any missing assignments, and discuss strategies designed to support academic progress and overall success.

Academic Assistance

TMS is offering an Academic Assistance Program during the Spring 2026 semester. Students who participate in the program will have access to additional academic support both before and after the regular school day.

After-school assistance will be available on Mondays and Wednesdays from 3:20 p.m. to 4:00 p.m., during which participating students will receive targeted help with coursework and assignments. In addition, before-school support sessions will be offered Monday through Thursday from 7:30 a.m. to 7:50 a.m., providing students with an opportunity to seek help, clarify concepts, or complete outstanding work prior to the start of the school day.

These sessions are designed to provide structured time and targeted academic support for students who may benefit from additional guidance.

Reading Allies

Reading Allies is a group of retired professionals who come to TMS four times per week to work with sixth-grade students. The group meets with students for forty minutes per day on a rotating basis. The goals of the program are to increase reading proficiency and develop positive associations with reading.

At Titusville Middle School, our Catalyst program is designed to create a truly personalized learning environment where every student is known, valued, and supported by at least one caring adult. We use Catalyst time to build meaningful relationships and provide consistent opportunities to monitor students' academic progress and overall school readiness, ensuring that each student has the support they need to succeed.

Our approach emphasizes connection and coaching, allowing staff to guide students not just academically, but socially and emotionally as well. Rather than focusing on traditional content, Catalyst is intentionally designed around student needs—helping us respond to challenges, celebrate growth, and support the whole child.
