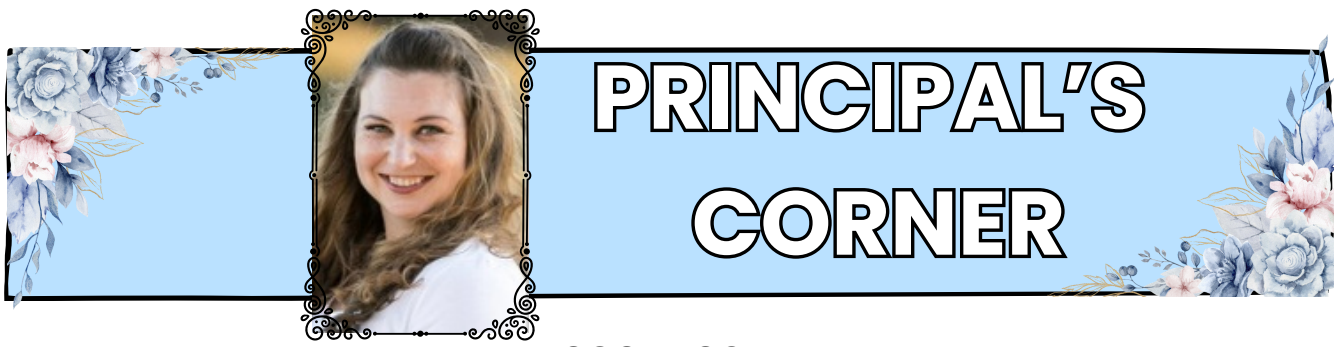

- *Make sure your student has a refillable water bottle for school with their name clearly written on it

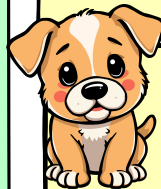
GOODBYE FROM MR. TOZY

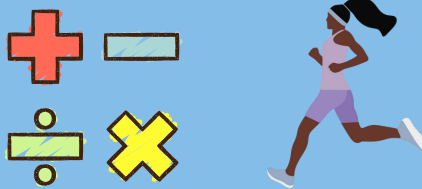
