After creating your account, contact the office to be placed on the CTE Testing appointment list.

Attend Your Testing Appointment

Students complete a CASAS Reading Assessment and receive their individual score report after testing.



4

Meet the Score Requirement

Students must achieve a CASAS Reading score of **239** or higher to be eligible to enroll in the MA, Phlebotomy, or NA programs.



5

Register May 1st

Gather all required documents and immunizations to register in person on May 1st at the Maple Campus.

- Registration is conducted on a first-come, first-served basis.
