Our Clinical & Administrative Medical Assisting course prepares students for all aspects of front- and back-office medical assisting, including routine diagnostic procedures such as EKGs. Medical Assistants perform routine administrative and clinical tasks in medical offices and clinics, including filing, completing medical forms, handling patient correspondence, scheduling appointments, and processing medical billing, such as CPT and ICD-10.

ENROLLMENT REQUIREMENTS

CASAS CTE Testing – Passing Score: 239

- Must be 18 years of age.
- HSD or equivalent
- CA Driver's license
- Birth Certificate or Equivalent
- Visa / Legal Right to work U.S.

VACCINATION REQUIREMENTS

- MMR - 2 doses or Titer Test
- Varicella - 2 doses or Titer Test
- Hepatitis B - 3 doses or Titer Test
- Tdap - 1 dose (within 10 years)
- COVID-19 Vaccine
- Influenza Vaccination (within last year)
- Two-step TB Test or Quantiferon TB GoldPlus Titer

PROGRAM EXPECTATIONS

For participation in the program, students must comply with the following:

- Attend Orientation
- Complete 160 Externship Hours
- Pass Background Check and Drug Screen
- Provide Physical Exam and TB Clearance
- No Acrylic Nails
- No Facial Piercings
- Attendance and Dress Code Strictly Enforced
- Program Calendar Provided on the First Day
