Learning How to Earn

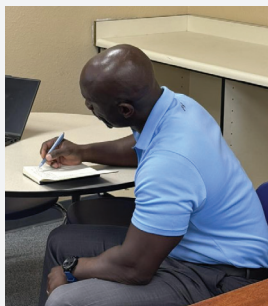
Lakin's First grade students are learning how to earn, spend, and save their money. They explored these skills with a board game. Way to go Leones!





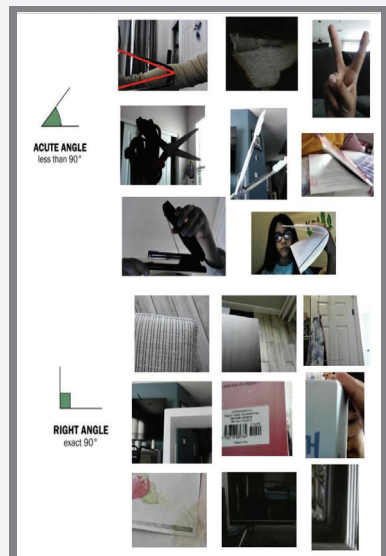
Littleton STEM is Sharing the Knowledge

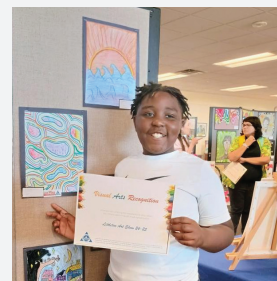
Camp Read S'mores Ignites 8th Grade Excitement
