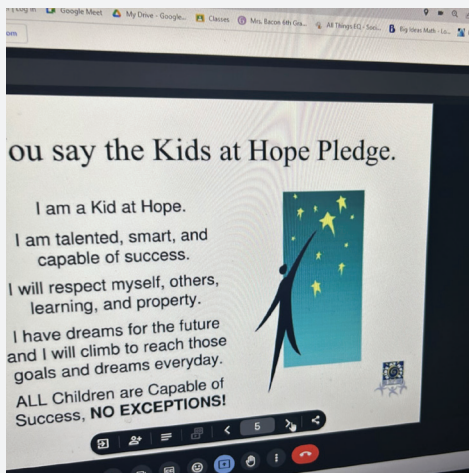
RECOGNIZING OUR AMAZING FIREBIRD TEACHERS

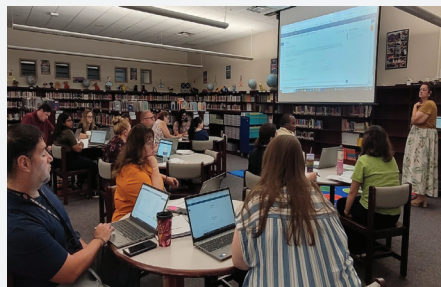
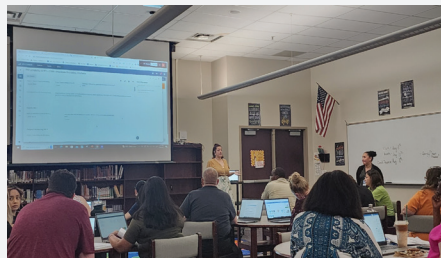
PLEDGING TO ALWAYS BE A KID AT HOPE, NO EXCEPTIONS!

LESD Online students are proud to be Kids at Hope! Students recite the pledge as a reminder of their greatness and potential. We are committed to support the success of all children. No exceptions!



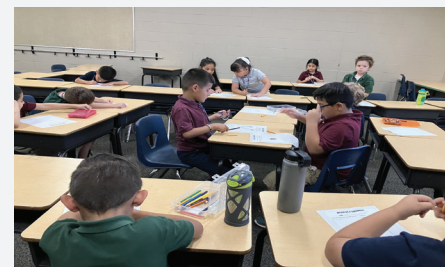
SUPPORTING OUR STUDENTS
