


Welcome to the 25-26 School Year






Lakin Prep

What a fantastic First Friday Assembly Lakin had. It was wonderful to see so many smiling faces come together to celebrate the end of the first week.


Also, it's been an amazing start to the school year at Lakin Prep Academy, and we're so proud of all the students. Go Leones!


