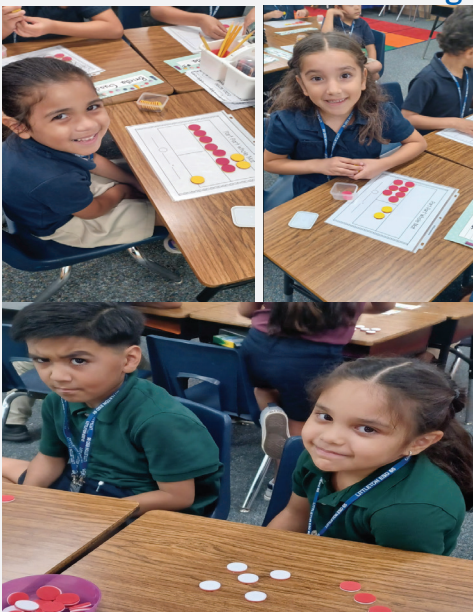
HAPPY RETIREMENT

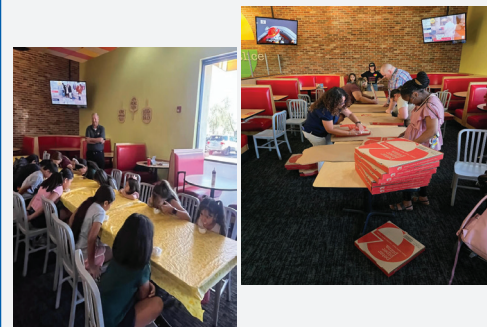


GRADE LEVEL SPOTLIGHT
