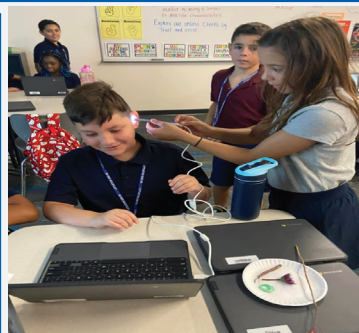
SET THE STAGE

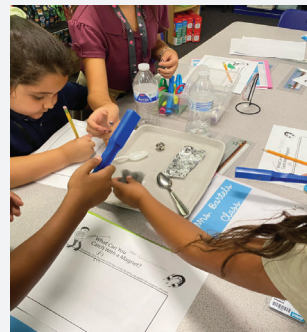
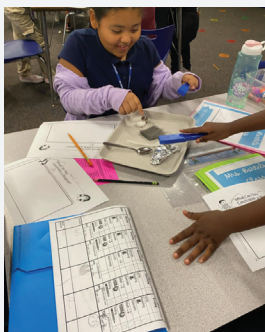

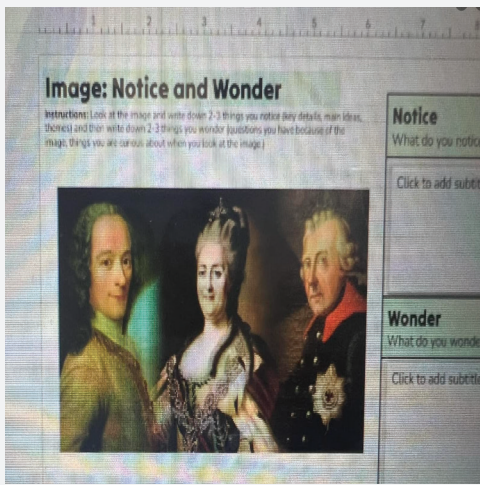
DID YOU KNOW?
