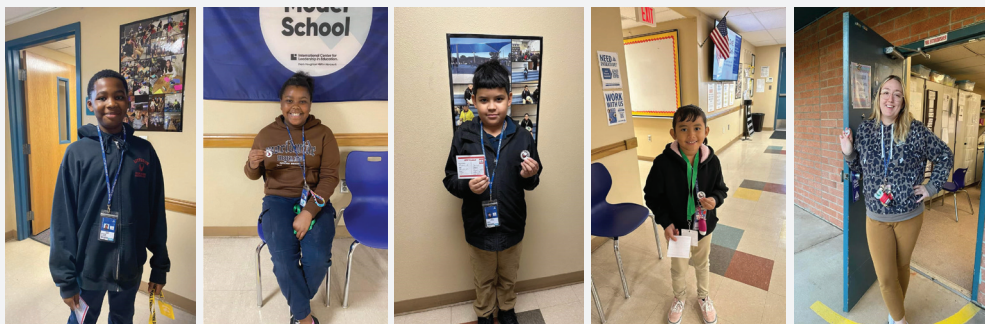

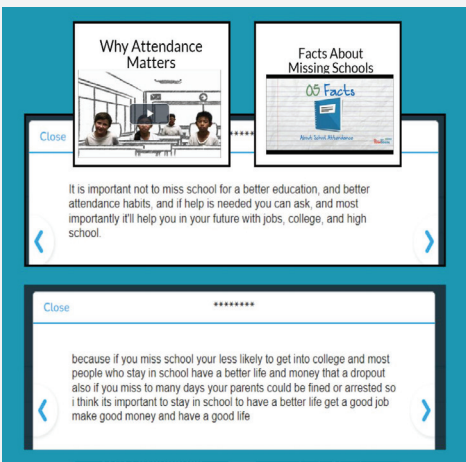
## RECOGNIZING OUR EPIC FIREBIRDS STUDENTS AND STAFF

Students were given a Near-pod lesson on the importance of having great attendance. At the end was an open-ended question to express the reasons they feel attending school is important to their future.



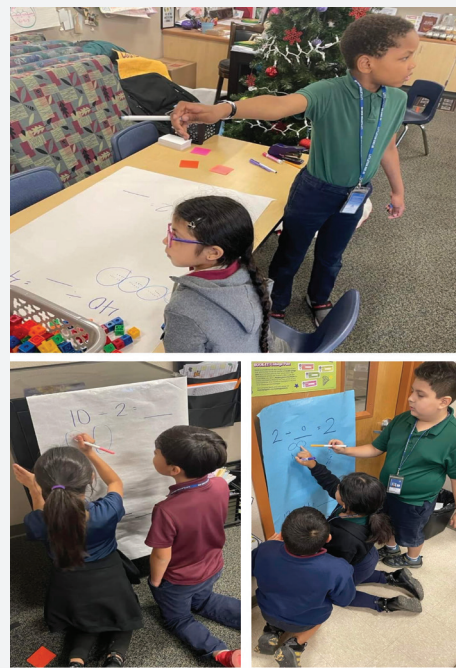
## CPR & FIRST AID TRAINING
