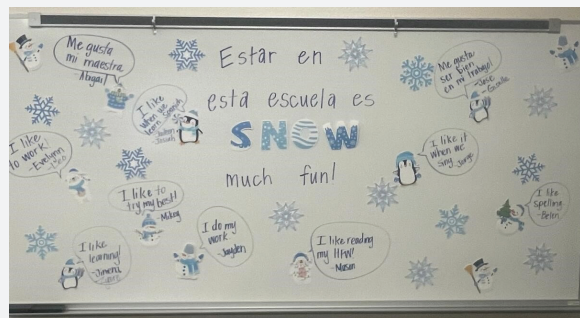
SPEAK UP, STAND UP, SAVE A LIFE CONFERENCE

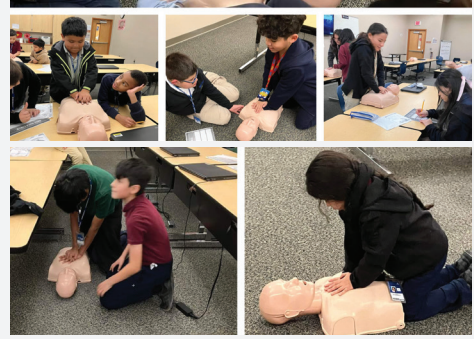
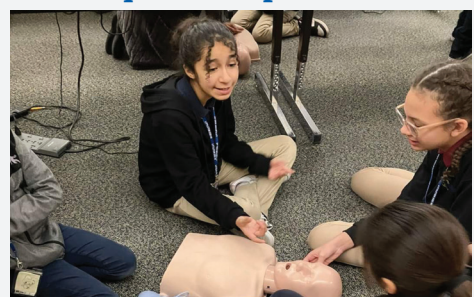
QUENTIN'S FIRST LITTLE MEDICAL CLINIC
