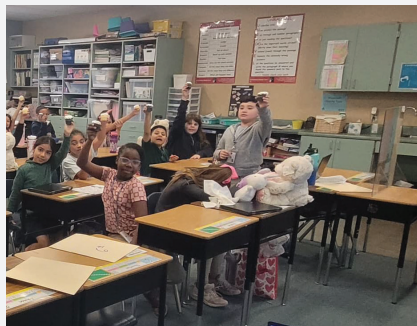
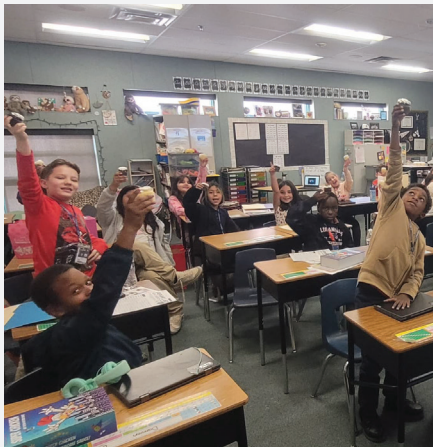




Arizona's Birthday

Kindergarten had a blast using marshmallows and toothpicks to explore 2D and 3D shapes.



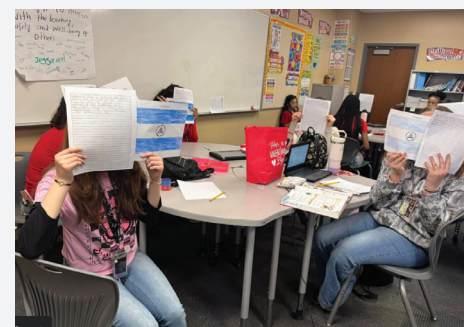
Love Celebration
