



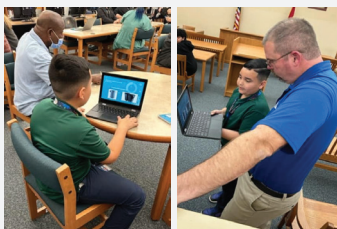

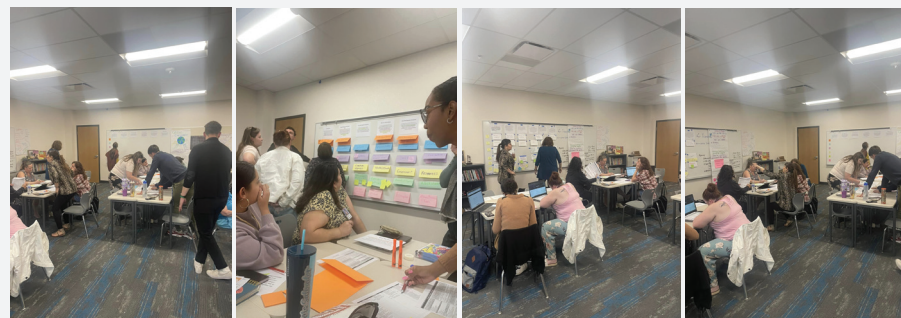
## EV HAWK LEADERS ATTENDING THE SUMMIT PLC
