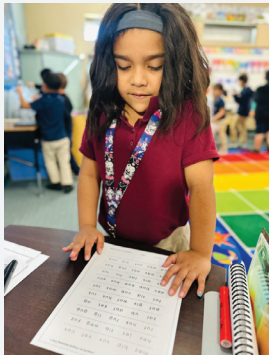
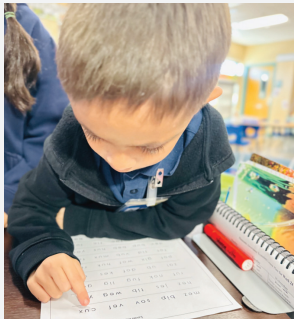




IAP Goals

Mrs. Gallegos' classes used their STEM Lab last week! The first graders worked in groups to create an obstacle course using prepositions.



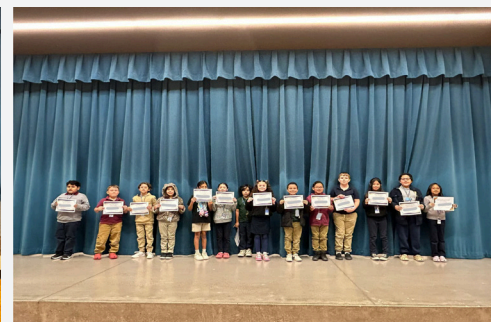
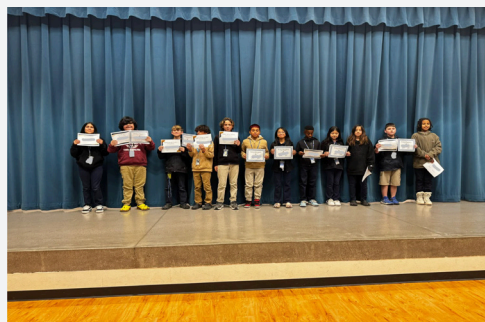
Missoula Children's Theatre

Fifth graders embraced the vibrant traditions of Lunar New Year with a parade full of fun and learning!



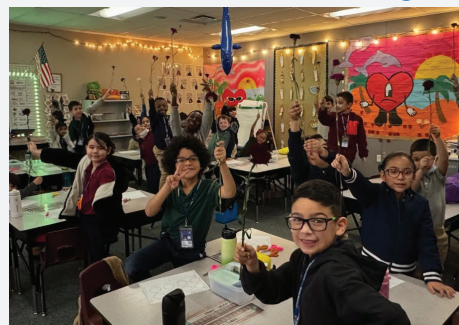
Tracking Progress

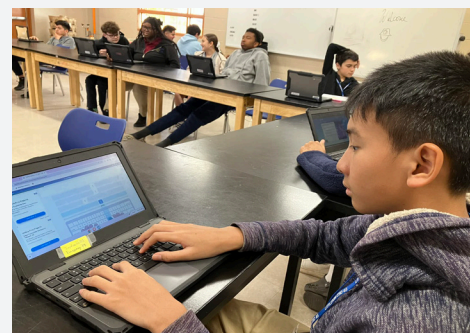
STEM Focus
