THANK YOU FOR OUR NEW MUSIC EQUIPMENT

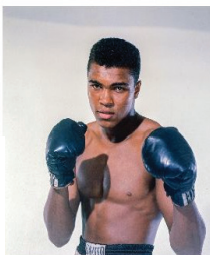
Our amazing EPIC music teacher Mr. Deaver was awarded money from Fiesta Bowl Charities to gain more equipment for his students.
