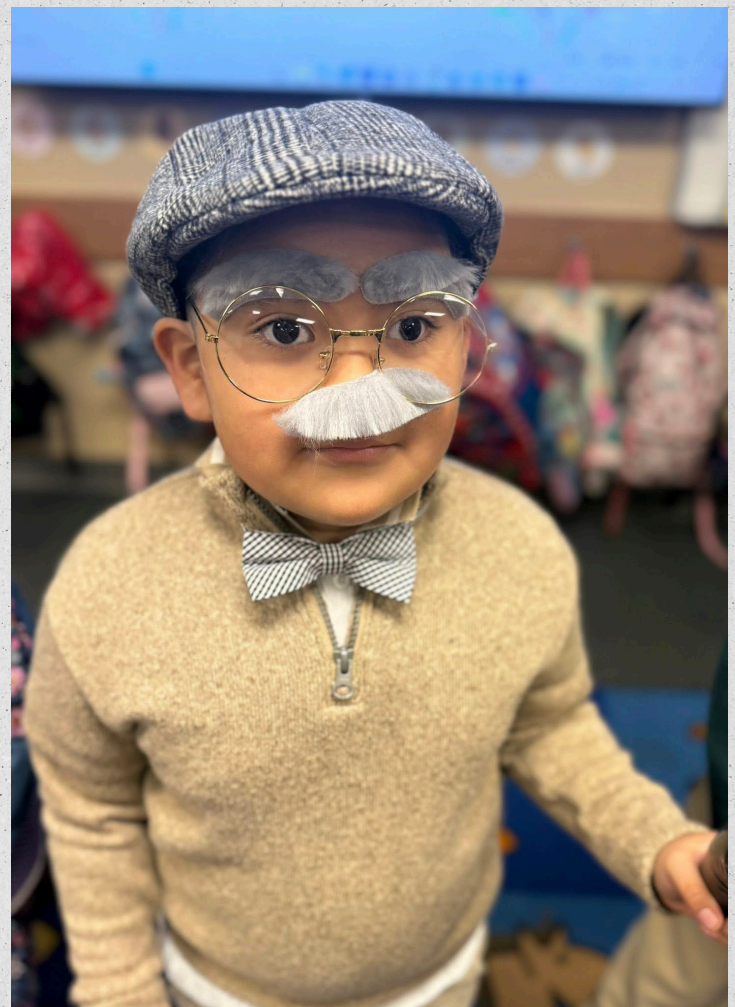

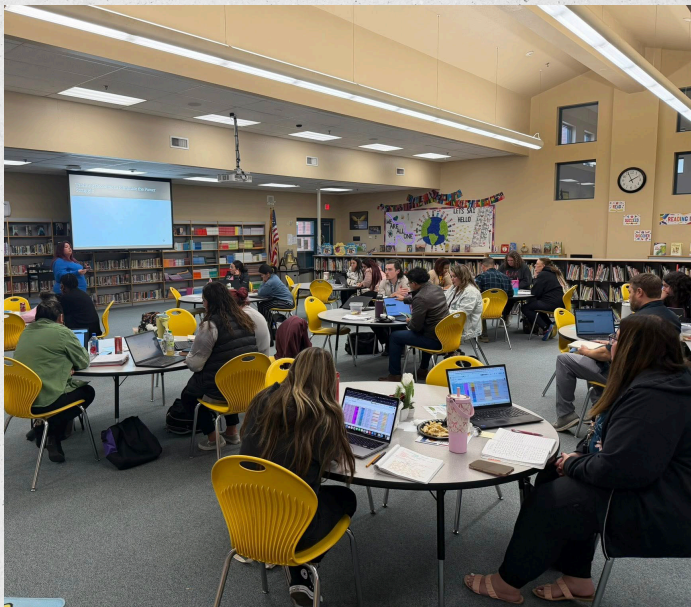
Lakin Prep



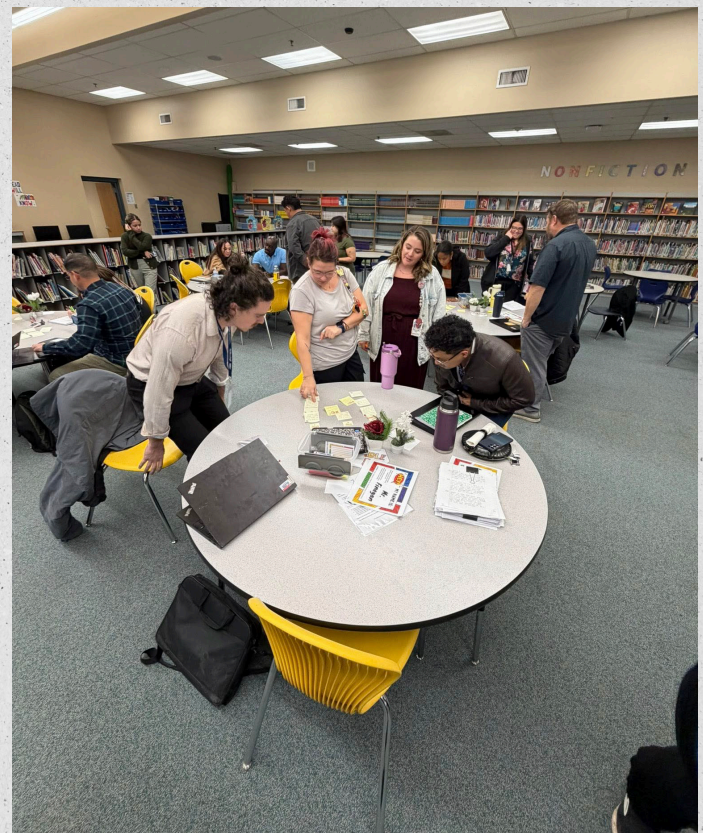
