

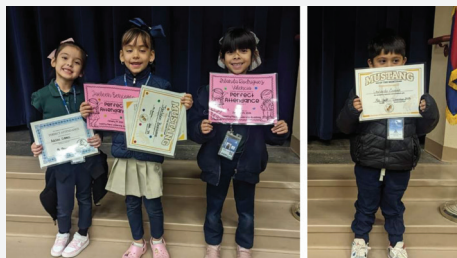

Congratulations to all of our Mustangs of the Month, Mighty Mustangs, Honor Roll and Principal's list students.



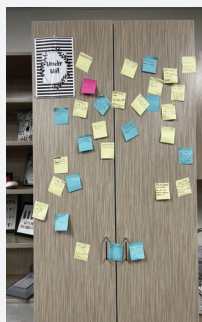
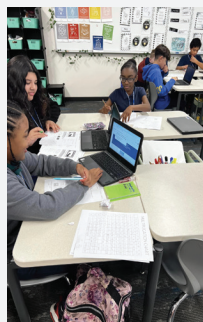
## CELEBRATING OUR 100TH DAY OF SCHOOL

## KINDNESS ARMY COMPLETED THEIR 100 DAYS OF SCHOOL MISSION

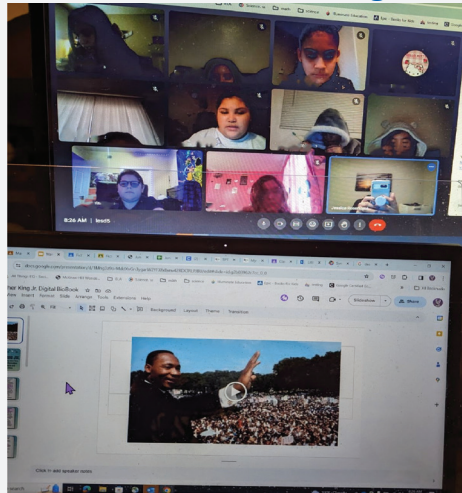
