STUDENT DRESS CODE FOR 2026-27 YEAR

As you prepare for the start of the 2026-27 School Year on Wednesday, July 29, Littleton ESD would like to remind all families that the student dress code has changed. Uniforms are no longer required. Please follow the below guidelines as you and your child start planning what they would like to wear.

General Requirements

Students must wear:

- Clothing that covers appropriate body parts with non-see-through material.
- Clothing that covers undergarments.
- Clothing that is appropriately sized.
- Shoes with a closed toe and back.
- School ID.

Prohibited items

- Clothing or accessories that display vulgar, lewd, obscene, offensive messages or images, weapons, violence, alcohol/drugs, or references an affiliation that affects the safety and well-being of others.
- Clothing or accessories that disrupt or interferes with the learning environment.
- Head coverings are not allowed indoors (except for headwear for health, safety, medical or religious purposes).
- Pajamas, durags, bandanas.

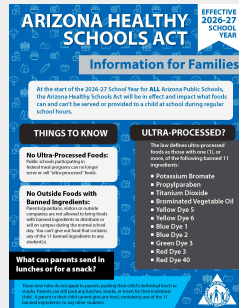
Summer Hours for Schools and District
