DRESS CODE FOR 26-27 SCHOOL YEAR

The Littleton ESD Governing Board approved a change to the student dress code effective for the 2026-27 School Year. Below is the information in the Parent Student Handbook.

General Requirements

Students must wear:

- Clothing that covers appropriate body parts with non-see-through material.
- Clothing that covers undergarments .
- Clothing that is appropriately sized.
- Shoes with a closed toe and back.
- School ID.

Prohibited items

- Clothing or accessories that display vulgar, lewd, obscene, offensive messages or images, weapons, violence, alcohol/drugs, or references an affiliation that affects the safety and well-being of others.
- Clothing or accessories that disrupt or interferes with the learning environment.
- Head coverings are not allowed indoors (except for headwear for health, safety, medical or religious purposes).
- Pajamas, durags, bandanas.



REMINDER

Annual Verification

All returning families must complete the Annual Verification process for the 2026-27 School Year. This important process ensures information is accurate in the event of an emergency or health needs arise. Also, if your child will be riding the bus, you will need to register them through this process or they won't be routed for a bus until it is complete.



Summer Hours for Schools and District

The Littleton District Office and all school sites will be open for Summer hours from Monday through Thursday until June 11. From June 12 through July 10, all school sites will be closed and reopen on July 13 in preparation of the 2026-27 School Year starting on Wednesday, July 29.
