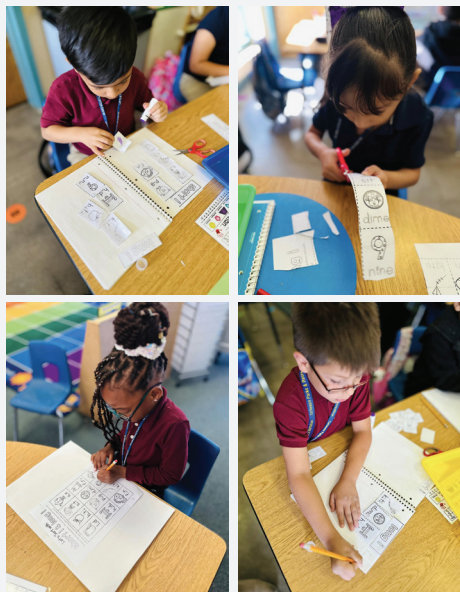

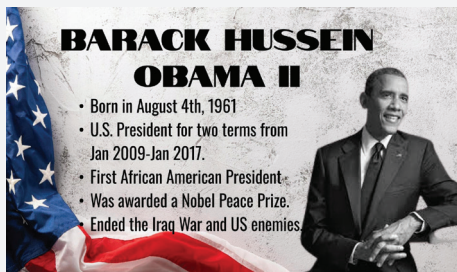
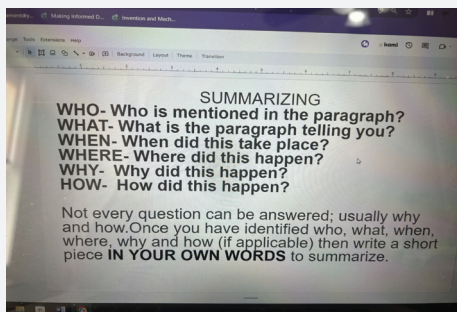
CONGRATULATIONS TO OUR NEW TEACHER OF THE YEAR MS. AVECHUCO!
