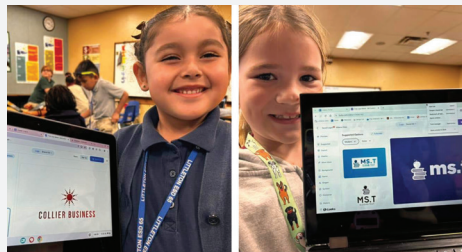




USING AI TECHNOLOGY TO GENERATE LOGOS

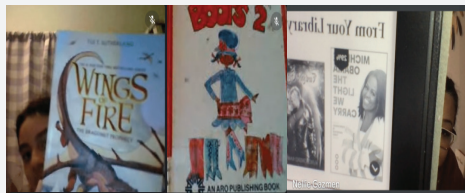
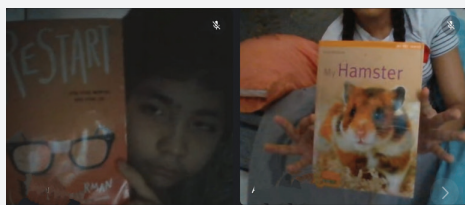
LEARNING ABOUT CODING AT WEST-MEC
