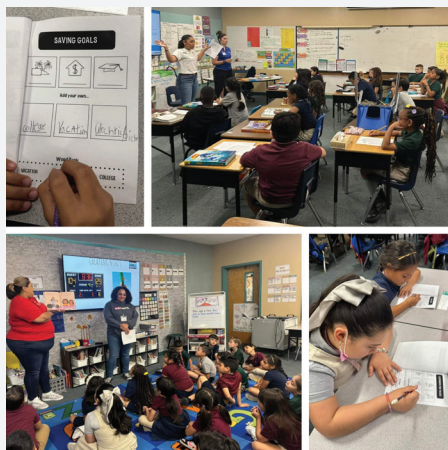

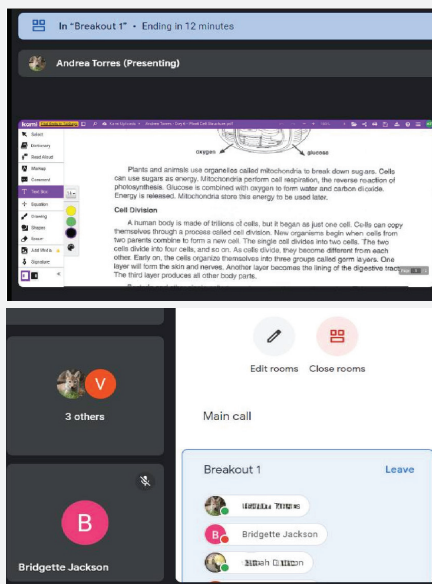
OUR TRIP TO THE PIONEER LIVING HISTORY MUSEUM

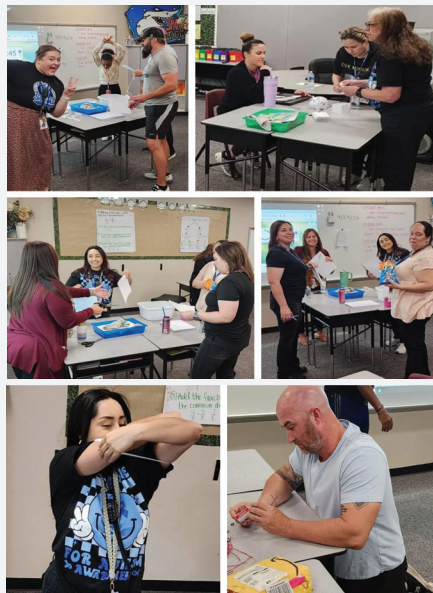
ATTENDANCE AND INTERVENTION ARE VERY IMPORTANT
