- D. The speaker hopes to caress his beloved.



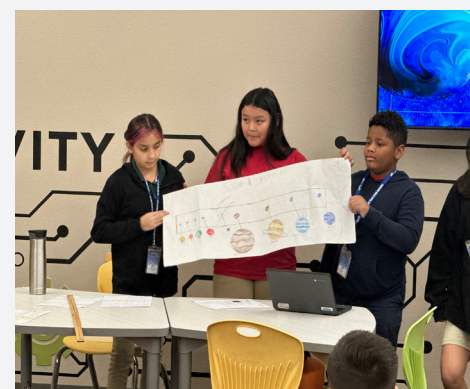
Trunk or Treat
