



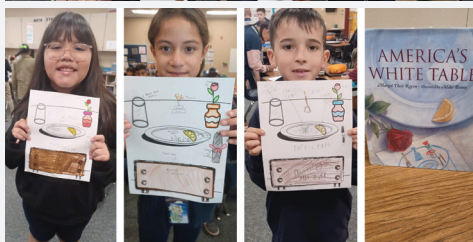
COYOTE BOYS BASKETBALL

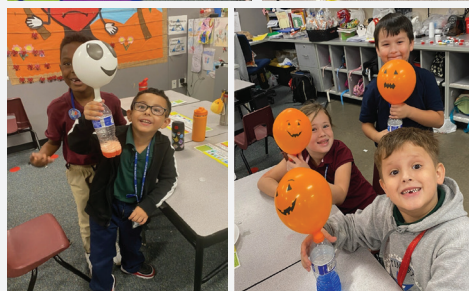
DIGITAL DUST DEVILS CELEBRATING SPIRIT WEEK
