Kinder Mustangs celebrated learning their letters by walking in the annual letter parade.



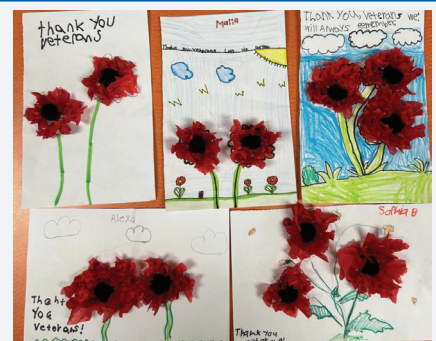
Engineering Lab

Mrs. Cappello's class voted last week to enjoy our new Engineering Lab, being the 1st class in the new space.



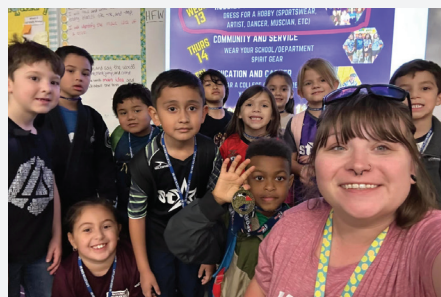
Honoring History
