

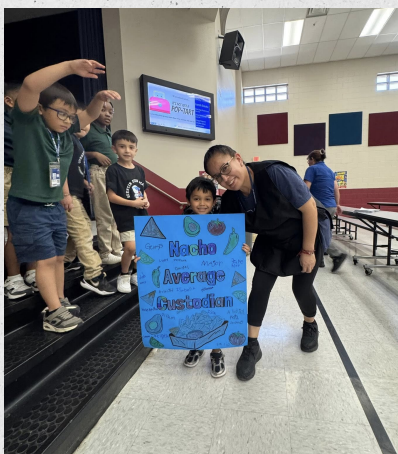


# Celebrating National Custodians/Maintenance Day

Students did painting, made necklaces, and sampled different apple foods.

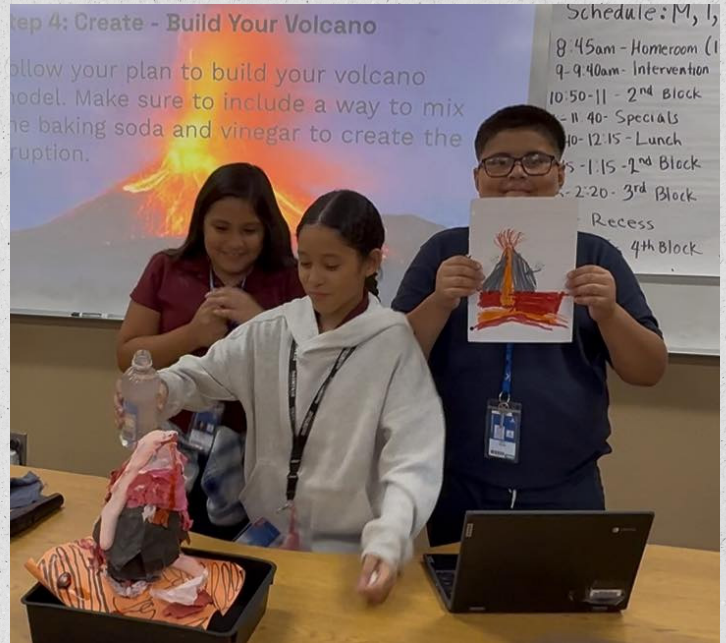
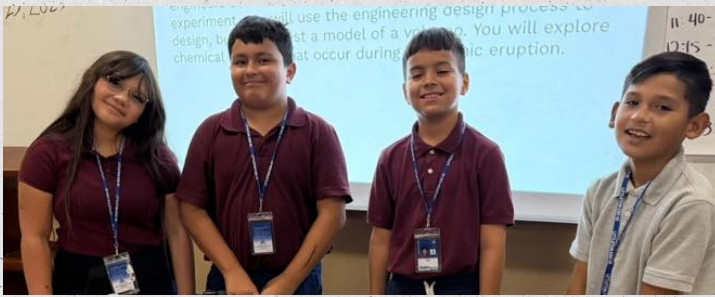






## Estrella Vista
