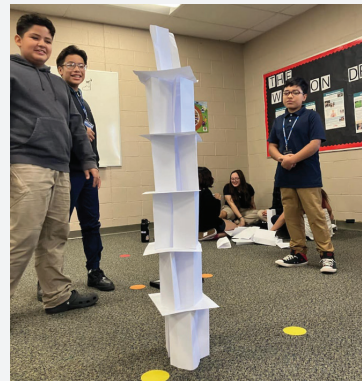
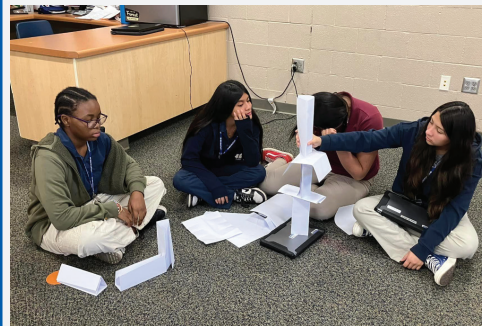
Kickball Showdown
