We had our Peter Piper Pizza Boo Bash night last Thursday for our fundraising! It was fun! Check our pictures wearing our scary and not so scary costumes.



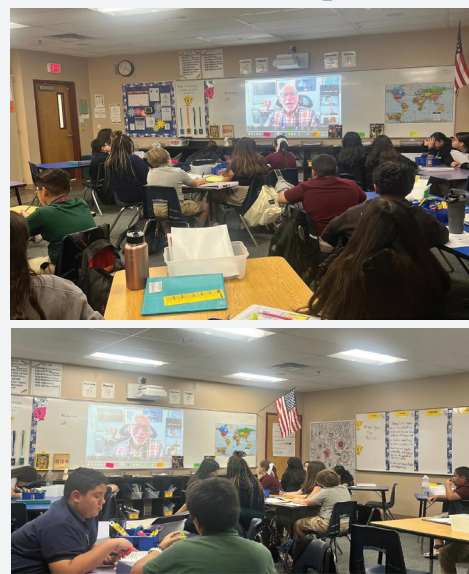
MUSTANGS OF THE MONTH

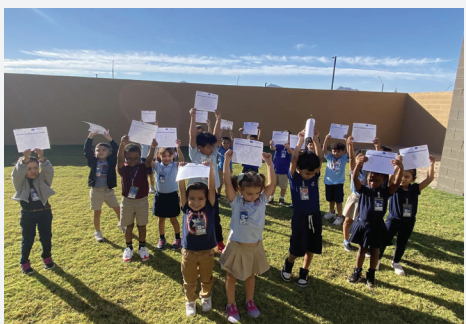
ZOOMING WITH CHARLES F. BOLDEN JR.

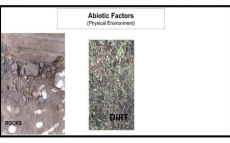
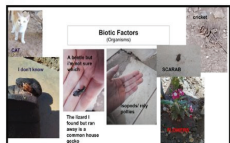
FIREBIRDS CELEBRATED ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENTS
