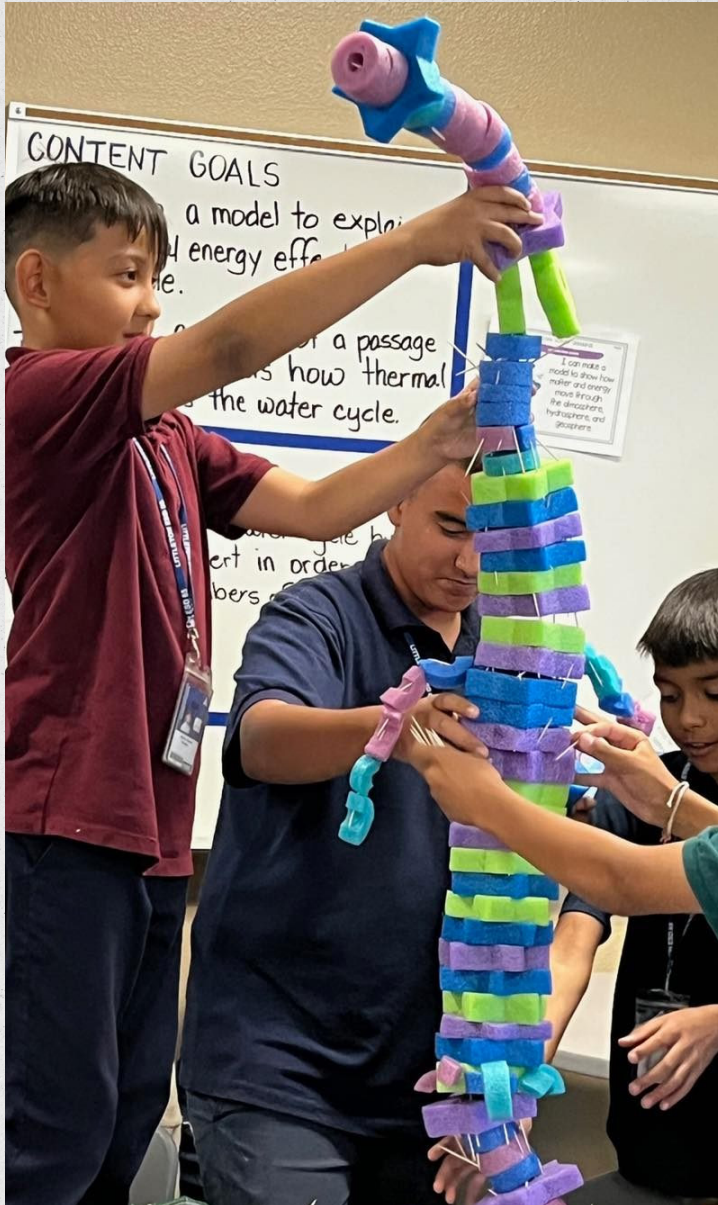




Estrella Vista

What an awesome way to spark innovation, teamwork, and hands-on learning.

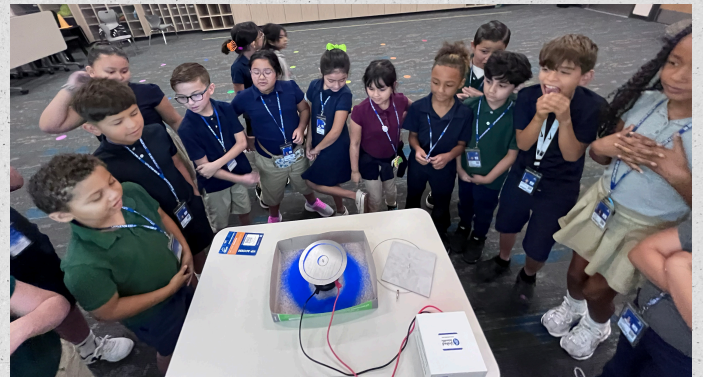


Lakin Prep



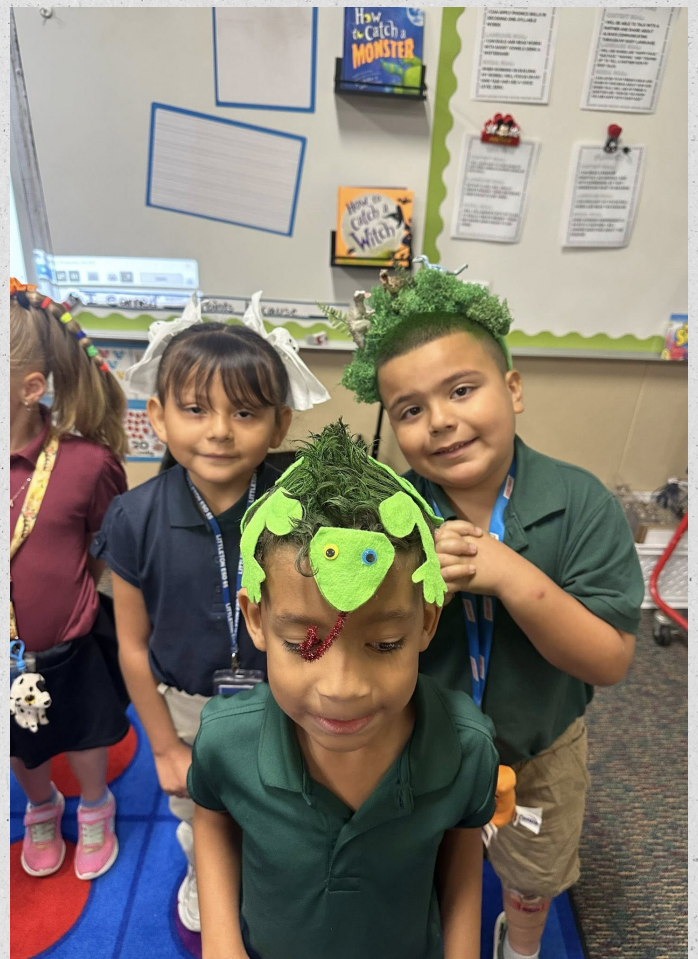
What a harmonious day in Mrs. Latu's music class! The Leones got super scientific, exploring the connections between music and science.

Crazy Hair Day was a blast! From wild spikes to colorful curls, our styles were as unique as we are! Even our Firebirds joined in on the fun!



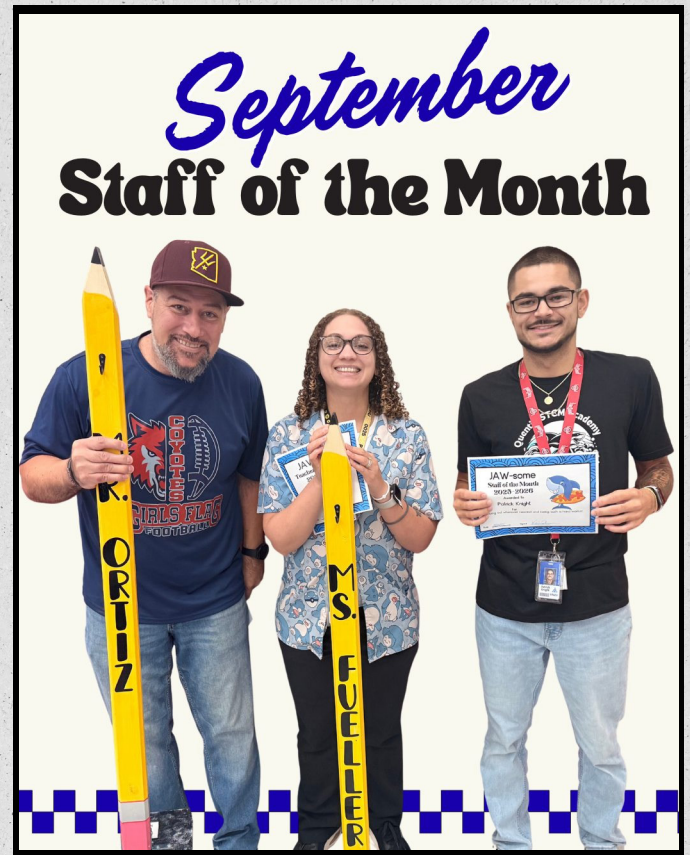


Quentin
